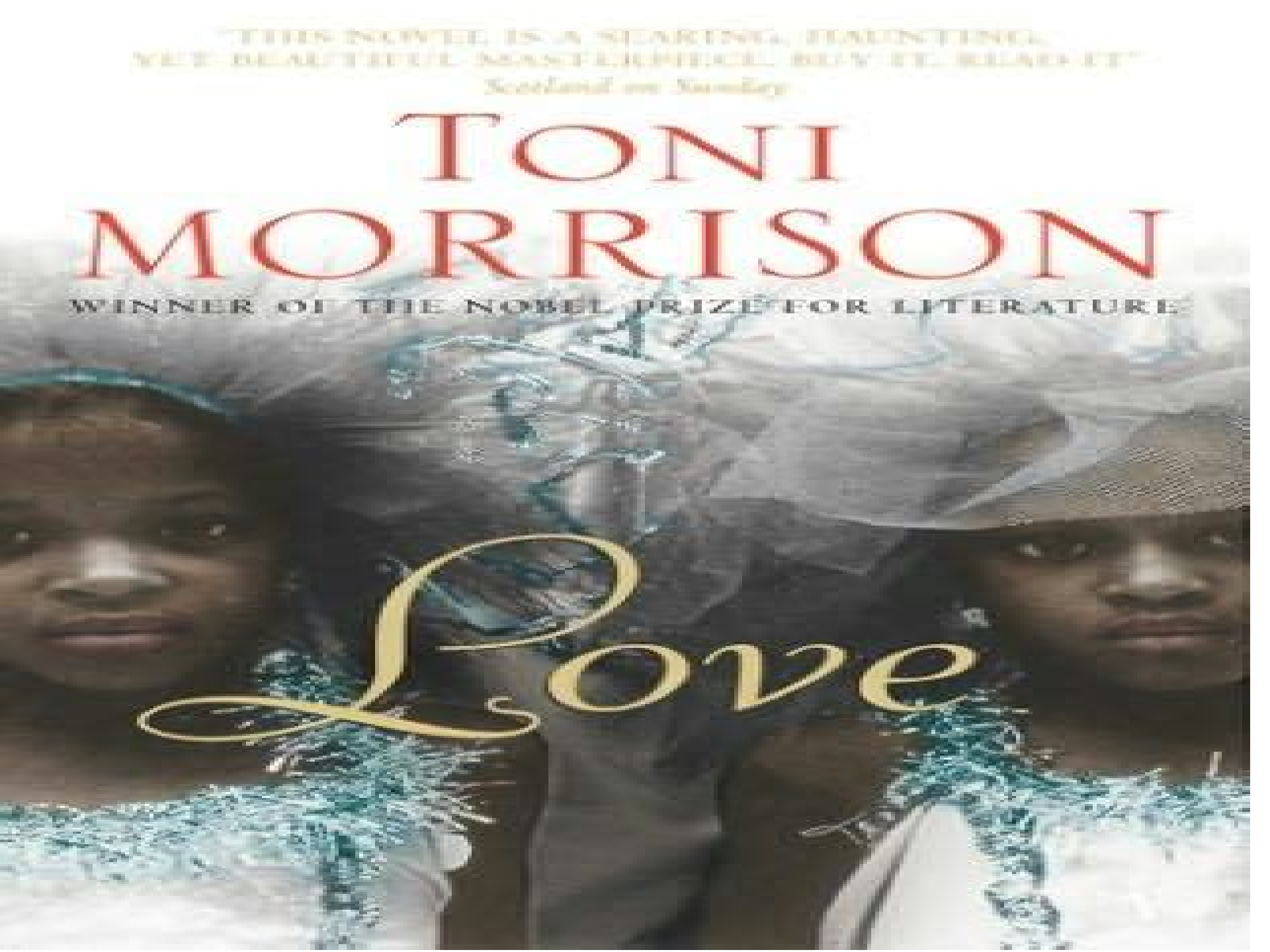

Like Schwarz, the essays look for intentionality of authorial meaning rather than something called an author function as well as for the relationship between lived experience and the imagined world of the literary work rather than the endless semiotic play of an ultimately indecipherable text.
