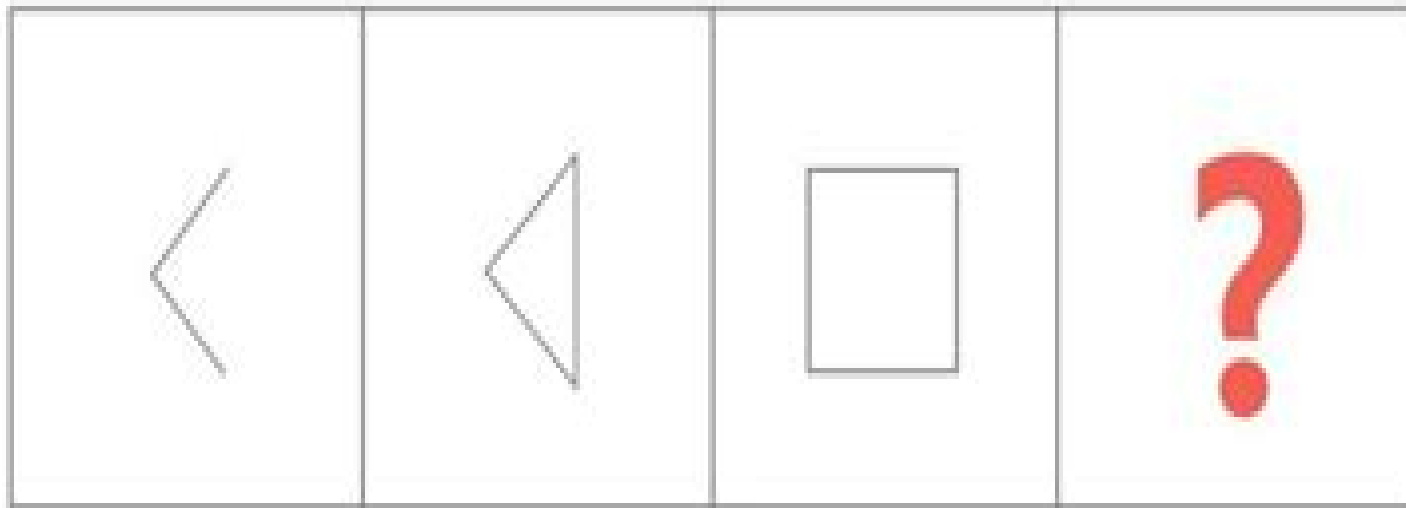
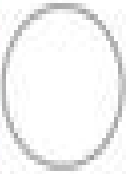
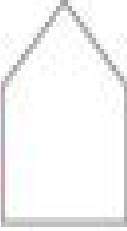

topic of assessment The goal for this workshop was to capitalize on the prior efforts and explore strategies for assessing the five skills identified earlier The Committee on the Assessment of 21st Century Skills was asked to organize a workshop that reviewed the assessments and related research for each of the five skills identified at the previous workshops with special attention to recent developments in technology enabled assessment of critical thinking and problem solving skills In designing the workshop the committee collapsed the five skills into three broad clusters as shown below Cognitive skills nonroutine problem solving critical thinking systems thinking Interpersonal skills complex communication social skills team work cultural sensitivity dealing with diversity Intrapersonal skills self management time management self development self regulation adaptability executive functioning Assessing 21st Century Skills provides an integrated summary of the presentations and discussions from both parts of the third workshop
