7. What is the purpose of the stranger and the townsman at the beginning of chapter 3? What information is the reader given through the conversation?
8. Who is Dimmesdale? What appeal does he use to convince Hester to reveal the baby's father? What is ironic about Dimmesdale's reaction to Hester's refusal to name the father of her child?
9. Who does the stranger turn out to be?
10. Explain Chillingworth's attitude toward Hester? What promise does she make him and why would she agree?
11. What is foreshadowed by Chillingworth and Hester's exchange at the end of chapter 4?
12. Considering the common use of physiognomy in pre-twentieth-century literature, what might Hawthorne be suggesting by portraying Hester as extremely beautiful? In contrast, what is Hawthorne suggesting by Chillingworth's aged, deformed appearance?

1. How is Hester's emergence from the prison at the end of her confinement different from her emergence on the day she stood in public humiliation?
2. What traditional dichotomy does Hawthorne begin to establish with the location of Hester's cottage?
