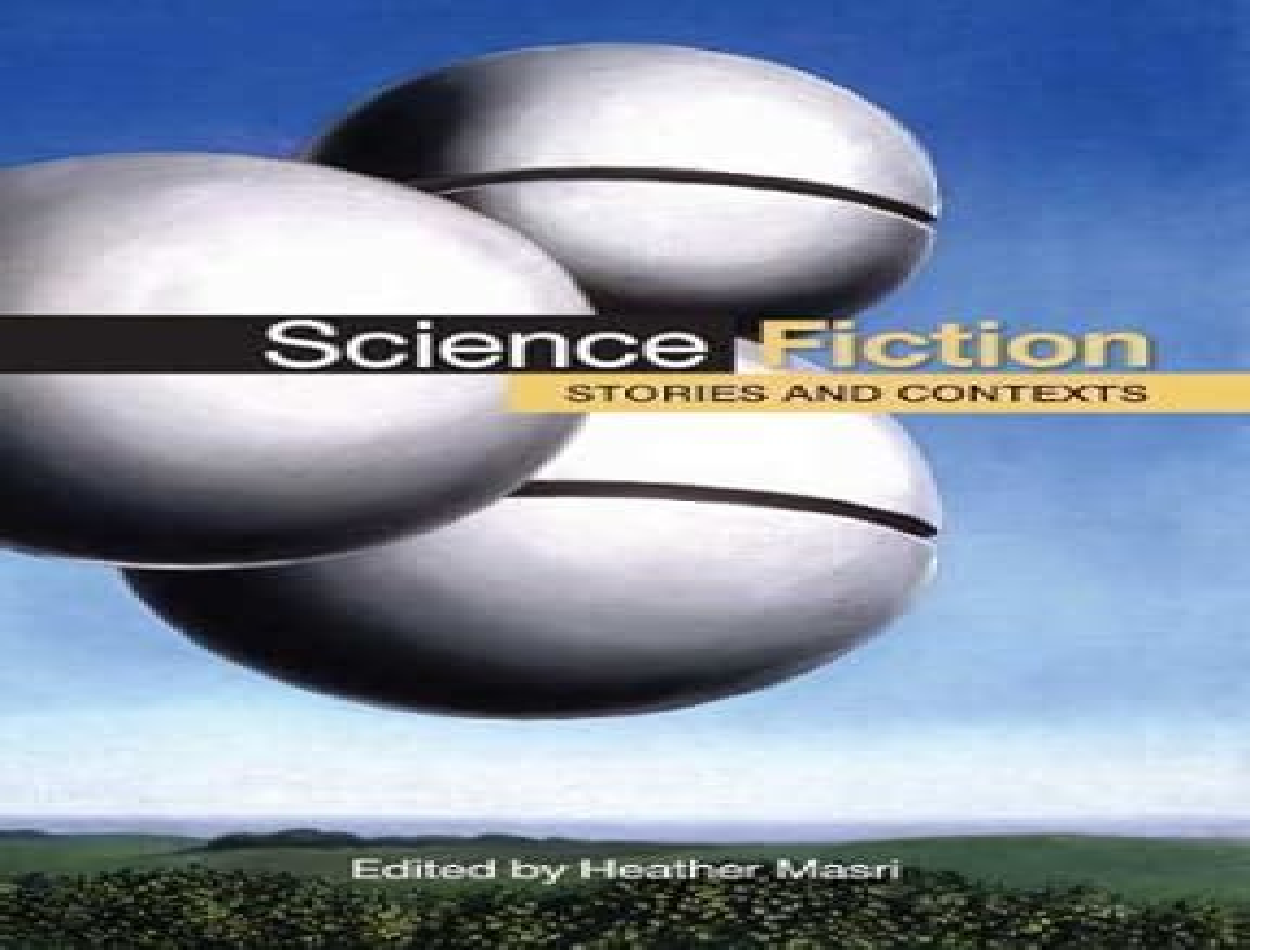

Miller, 2013 This collection of essays explores the social and cultural aspects of steampunk examining the various manifestations of this multi-faceted genre in order to better understand the steampunk sub culture and its effect on and interrelationship with popular culture and the wider society Narrative Comprehension Catherine Emmott, 1997 Despite the current explosion of interest in cognitive linguistics there has so far been relatively little research by cognitive linguists on narrative comprehension Emmott draws on insights from discourse analysis and artificial intelligence to present a detailed model of how readers build maintain and use mental representations of fictional contexts and how they keep track of characters and contexts within a complex changing fictional world The work has implications for linguistic theory since it questions several long held assumptions about anaphora arguing for a levels of consciousness model for the processing of referring expressions The book begins with a summary of current issues in text processing theory and a discussion of the methodological importance of recognizing the hierarchical structure of discourse The core of the book explores the significance of contextual monitoring in narrative comprehension and looks particularly at the cognitive demands placed on readers by flashbacks Later chapters examine the implications of contextual monitoring for reference theory and for a literary linguistic model of

Understanding Bollywood Ulka Anjaria, 2021-03-04 This book offers an introduction to popular Hindi cinema a genre that has a massive fan base but is often misunderstood by critics and provides insight on topics of political and social significance Arguing that Bollywood films are not realist representations of society or expressions of conservative ideology but mediated texts that need to be read for their formulaic and melodramatic qualities and for their pleasurable features like bright costumes catchy music and sophisticated choreography the book interprets Bollywood films as complex considerations on the state of the nation that push the boundaries of normative gender and sexuality The book provides a careful account of Bollywood s constitutive components its moral structure its different forms of love its use of song and dance its visual style and its embrace of cinephilia Arguing that these five elements form the core of Bollywood cinema the book investigates a range of films from 1947 to the present in

order to show how films use and innovate formulaic structures to tell a wide range of stories that reflect changing times The book ends with some considerations on recent changes in Bollywood cinema suggesting that despite globalization the future of Bollywood remains promising By presenting Bollywood cinema through an interdisciplinary lens the book reaches beyond film studies departments and will be useful for those teaching and studying Bollywood in English sociology anthropology Asian studies and cultural studies classes

What Stories are Thomas M. Leitch, 1986 A sophisticated and closely reasoned essay on narrative theory which begins by attacking the customary distinction between story narrated events and discourse narrating medium What Stories Are suggests an alternative definition of narrative based on its discursive properties and explores the implications of that definition for the traditional categories of narrative theory plot character and so on This book combines two main tendencies in the study of narrative over the last twenty years one toward the building of bigger and better structural systems the other toward the production of ever finer and more intricate interpretations of particular texts In accurately and fairmindedly presenting previous and alternative theories of narrative the author attains a striking degree of originality redefining the subject in new and significant ways What Stories Are is outstanding for the logic and integrity of its intellectual design and for the catholicity of its interests and tastes Leitch is impressively at home in the literature he treats and his formulation of the constitutive tension in narrative between teleological and discursive imperatives freshly articulates it and gives it a welcome and unwonted centrality
