Press brake forming

Press brake forming is the process where metal is bent or folded when a die and a punch are used to bend the sheet of metal.

This is most often used to form parts from ferrous alloy and green for both prototype and production runs.

The maximum sheet thickness is ideally less than 8 times the

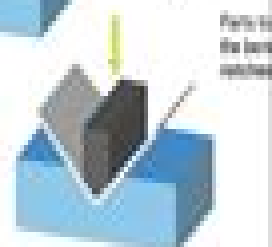

Forming near holes

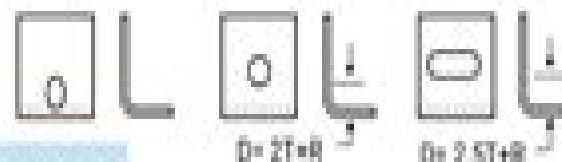
When a part is made too close to a hole, the hole may become deformed. To save the cost of punching or drilling in a secondary operation, the following formula can be used to calculate the minimum distance required.

As a rule of thumb, the distance from the outside of the material to the bottom of the cutout should be equal to the minimum flange length as prescribed by the air bend force chart.

For a hole $\geq 1"$ diameter the minimum distance $"D" \geq 2T + R$

For a slot or hole $< 1"$ diameter the minimum distance $"D" \geq 1.5T + R$

When using a punch press, or laser cutting, holes should never be less than that of the material thickness.



The minimum distance to material thickness for bend radius

Feature Type	Minimum distance guideline
Between hole and a bend	at least the material length + bend radius
Between slot and a bend	at least the material thickness + bend radius
Between hole to slot and edge	at least the material thickness
Between adjacent internal holes	at least the material thickness
Between a punched hole and an edge	at least the material thickness
Between a punched hole and bend	at least the material thickness + bend radius
Between adjacent holes and a bend	at least the material thickness + bend radius
Between adjacent holes	at least the material thickness
