Campbell's Psychiatric Dictionary Robert Jean Campbell, 2004 Defines words and concepts currently used in psychiatry Incorporates new terms and diagnostic criteria on DSM IV as well as terms from the WHO levicons on mental disorders and on alcoholism and other substance dependency that will accompany ICD 10 *A Historical Dictionary of Psychiatry* Edward Shorter, 2005 This is the first historical dictionary of psychiatry It covers the subject from autism to Vienna and includes the key concepts individuals places and institutions that have shaped the evolution of psychiatry and the neurosciences An introduction puts broad trends and international differences in context and there is an extensive bibliography for further reading Each entry gives the main dates themes and personalities involved in the unfolding of the topic Longer entries describe the evolution of such subjects as depression schizophrenia and psychotherapy The book gives ready reference to when things happened in psychiatry how and where they happened and who made the main contributions In addition it touches on such social themes as women in psychiatry criminality and psychiatry and homosexuality and psychiatry A comprehensive index makes immediately accessible subjects that do not appear in the alphabetical listing Among those who will appreciate this dictionary are clinicians curious about the origins of concepts they use in their daily practices such as paranoia selective serotonin reuptake inhibitors SSRIs or tardive dyskinesia basic scientists who want ready reference to the development of such concepts as neurotransmitters synapse or neuroimaging students of medical history keen to situate the psychiatric narrative within larger events and the general public curious about illnesses that might affect them their families and their communities or readers who merely want to know about the grand chain of events from the asylum to Freud to Prozac Bringing together information from the English French German Italian and Scandinavian languages the Dictionary rests on an enormous base of primary sources that cover the growth of psychiatry through all of Western society

000 essential words and phrases spanning all psychological and psychiatric disciplines both research and clinical Wiley's English Spanish and Spanish English Dictionary of Psychiatry and Psychology provides a ready reference to more than 62 000 essential terms and phrases from all disciplines and subdisciplines in psychiatry and psychology Renowned professional translator Steven M Kaplan **Antipsychiatry** Thomas Szasz, 2009-09-08 More than fifty years ago Thomas Szasz showed that the concept of mental illness a disease of the mind is an oxymoron a metaphor a myth Disease in the medical sense affects only the body He also demonstrated that civil commitment and the insanity defense the paradigmatic practices of psychiatry are incompatible with the political values of personal responsibility and individual liberty The psychiatric establishment's rejection of Szasz's critique posed no danger to his work its defense of coercions and excuses as therapy supported his argument regarding the metaphorical nature of mental illness and the transparent immorality of brutal psychiatric control masquerading as humane medical care In the late 1960s the launching of the so called antipsychiatry movement vitiated Szasz's effort to present a precisely formulated conceptual and political critique of the medical identity of psychiatry Led by the Scottish psychiatrist R D Laing the antipsychiatrists used the term to attract attention to themselves and to deflect attention from what they did which included coercions and excuses based on psychiatric principles and power For this reason Szasz rejected and continues to reject psychiatry and antipsychiatry with equal vigor Subsuming his work under the rubric of antipsychiatry betrays and negates it just as surely and effectively as subsuming it under the rubric of psychiatry In *Antipsychiatry Quackery Squared* Szasz powerfully argues that his writings belong to neither psychiatry nor antipsychiatry They stem from conceptual analysis social political criticism and common sense **The American Journal of Psychiatry** ,1923 *Guide to the Literature in Psychiatry* Bernice Ennis, 1971 Comprehensive handbook that lists and describes titles and resources available through the literature of psychiatry Intended primarily for psychiatrists in teaching training research and clinical application but also useful to related health personnel Chapters usually with annotated entries include psychiatric journals information sources books non book materials government documents controlled circulations translators and translations libraries and publishers General index **Archives of Neurology and Psychiatry** ,1922

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
