COURSE DESCRIPTION

REA 0017(Developmental Reading II) develops reading and thinking skills that are necessary for success in college classes. This course will emphasize critical (inferential), rather than literal, reading skills. Due to the emphasis on critical comprehension, this course is as much a course in **thinking** as it is in reading. Reading is a skill--a means rather than an end--and like all skills, practice is necessary to achieve mastery. Thus, three hours of classroom instruction plus
