MARCO NORMATIVO RELACIONADO CON LA ÉTICA:

La ética normativa es reconocida como una rama de la filosofía que se centra en determinar qué es moralmente correcto e incorrecto, permisibles o no, incluso se reconoce lo bueno y lo malo, éste implica directamente analizar principios éticos y emitir juicios sobre cómo deberían comportarse los individuos y las sociedades, esto podría implicar proporcionar análisis, recomendaciones y marcos para consideraciones éticas en diversos contextos, como negocios, atención médica o relaciones personales.

En cuanto al marco normativo, podemos reconocer el Código de Ética (2017), el cual prevé la resolución de conflictos y adicionalmente la evaluación de las conductas en cuanto al servicio público, citando lo siguiente:

"El Código de Ética representa el compromiso de cada servidor para mantener los más altos niveles éticos en el cumplimiento de su deber, y con su implementación se espera que cada uno de los funcionarios logre interiorizar los valores y principios que identifican y guían la cultura institucional del Ministerio de Justicia y del Derecho, en relación con los patrones de comportamiento como funcionario público"

En el ámbito de la ética, un marco regulatorio sólido es crucial para garantizar la rendición de cuentas y mantener estándares éticos, por ende, la ética se refiere a los principios que gobiernan la conducta moral y guían a los individuos y organizaciones hacia las acciones correctas.

Cuando se trata de establecer un marco regulatorio relacionado con la ética, implica implementar pautas, leyes y políticas que definan el comportamiento aceptable en diversos contextos, debido a que dichas regulaciones protegen contra prácticas poco éticas en áreas como negocios, atención médica, tecnología y más. Al contar con un marco regulatorio sólido relacionado con la ética, las sociedades pueden defender la justicia, proteger los derechos de las personas, fomentar la confianza entre las partes interesadas y prevenir daños.

Ahora bien, es importante mencionar que el establecer límites claros para el comportamiento aceptable y al mismo tiempo proporciona consecuencias por las infracciones. Además, este marco regulatorio sirve como elemento disuasivo al establecer mecanismos para monitorear el cumplimiento de estándares éticos. También alienta a las organizaciones e individuos a considerar de manera proactiva las implicaciones éticas al tomar decisiones o realizar sus operaciones. (Salazar, B. 1967).
