
## Basic Assumptions in Describing Function Analysis:

Consider a nonlinear system in the general form of Figure 4. In order to develop the basic version of the describing function method, the system has to satisfy the following four conditions:

- Ther is only a single nonlinear components
- The nonlinear component is time invariant (saturation, backlash, Coulomb friction, etc.)
- Corresponding to a sinusoidal input x=sin(ωt), only the fundamental component w<sub>1</sub>(t) in the output w(t) has to be considered. |G(ωt) >> |G(nωt) for n = 2,3,...
- The nonlinearity is odd (symmetry about the origin).
