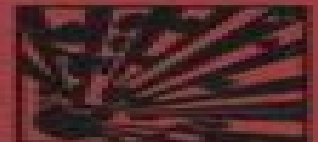

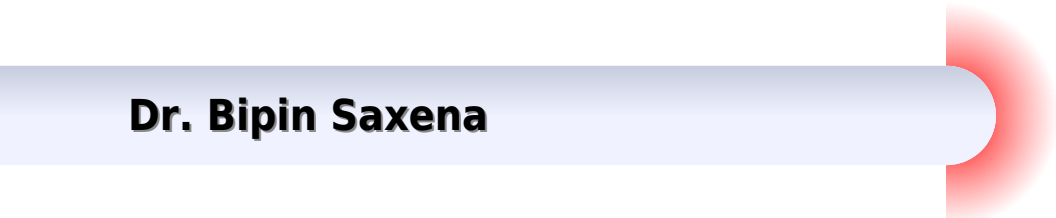

The empirical design of a Safety Culture Maturity Development Model Marcell Greeff, 2023-05-17 This book outlines the research of Dr Marcell Greeff that has developed a

Safety Culture Maturity Development Model SCMDM for companies to measure and improve their organizational safety culture The research followed an empirical design with a positivist philosophy and a mixed methodology approach therefore using a survey in a cross sectional time frame The author critically reviewed existing literature and confirmed that there is no clear understanding of how to design a SCMDM as well as what safety elements factors to include in a SCMDM in order to measure this The benefits of a good safety culture are well documented and as a result there are many case studies available on the benefits and costs of occupational health and safety Adopting a good safety culture SC seeds the foundation of strategic competitive advantages for businesses in the contemporary corporate landscape The lack of a good safety culture could be catastrophic and there are many recent examples including the Grenfell Tower fire incident in London UK on 14 June 2017 or the well known 1986 Chernobyl disaster where the term Safety Culture first made its appearance in the 1987 OECD Nuclear Agency report Marcell found that it is the case in many countries and industries that there is no unified consolidated or government mandated mechanism that UAE Utility companies can use to operationalize SC to positively influence the safety performance of their businesses and identify specific actions to improve their safety culture with regards to the SCMDM he designed There is ample research to support this research topic which also confirms a clear link to theory The author s SCMDM provides an organisation with a simple understanding of the current level of their SC and will also give them data that will allow better insights into some of the basic assumptions underlying a company s SC He investigated the design history of popular and influential SCMDM s and their practical implementation today for the blueprint of his SCMDM The models reviewed originated from both quality and organizational development models as well as capability maturity models The author s SCMDM was designed to allow organisations to understand their level of safety culture maturity by assessing the level of compliance with various key elements factors of SC across several stages that represents different levels of maturity The elements factors affecting SC were critically reviewed and confirmed as Safety Management Systems SMS Management Commitment MCM and Employee Involvement EI in essence selected as independent variables for the study with Safety Culture SC as the dependant variable Four appropriate sub factors dimensions were identified for every element factor and a total of 16 sub factors were included in the SCMDM The author developed his SCMDM into a quantitative research questionnaire with a 5 point Likert scale format as a data collection tool that is matching the 5 levels of SC maturity to assess the level of SC maturity in UAE Utilities Any company can use this SCMDM to progress and develop its SC maturity through the 5 stages of Culture Maturity starting on a journey from emerging the lowest SC maturity level to managing stage then to involvement level to cooperation and finally reaching the highest maturity level continuous improvement for every element factor mentioned above and the 16 sub factors The researcher s SCMDM quantitative research questionnaire was distributed to 500 UAE Utility industry staff to complete of which 386 responded Primary data was collected and coded as per the prescribed scheme for quantitative analysis through SPSS 21 The two different types of

tests that were run on the coded primary data was Frequency Analysis tests and Hypothesis tests Frequency Analysis tests included Skewness and Kurtosis Pearson s Correlation Analysis Coefficient Kaiser Meyer Olkin KMO and Bartlett s Test Exploratory Data Statistical Analysis EFA to calculate the eigenvalues for a Scree Plot Principal Component Analysis and Rotation method Varimax with Kaiser normalization The Hypothesis tests included Multiple Linear Regression Analysis Independent Samples t test with the help of SPSS 21 and One Way ANOVA in SPSS 21 Based on the statistical test results it was statistically proven that SMS MCM and EI does in fact impact SC in UAE Utilities further validating the SCMDM The comprehensive analysis of the case study that was conducted qualitative interviews validated the findings of the quantitative data frequency analysis outlined above In conclusion the findings of the primary research conducted for this study are completely in synchronization with those of existing literature and the quantitative findings The effect of the main factors i e EI MCM and SMS is computed to be statistically and qualitatively established in order to be valid and significant The findings of the study based on both qualitative and quantitative assessments established that the average of each safety subfactor is equal to 4 and in terms of the SCMDM are in the fourth stage meaning that the safety culture of the UAE s utility industry is currently in the cooperation stage Detailed recommendations on how to progress beyond this cooperation stage 4 are discussed in this book as well as implications of its findings and recommendations for future research
