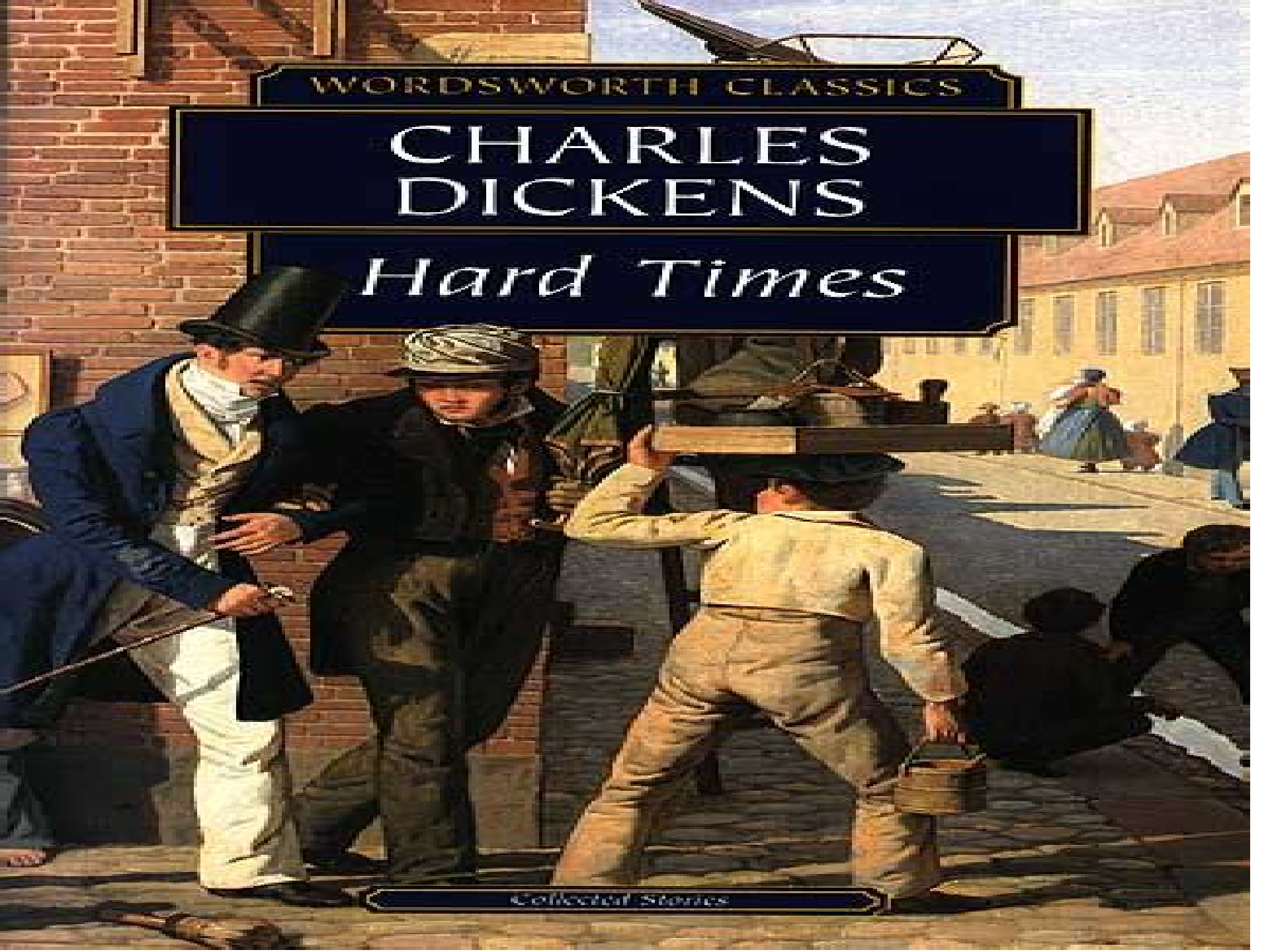

Tempi difficili Charles Dickens, 2011-03-10 Cura e traduzione di Mario Martino Edizione integrale Scritto intorno alla metà dell'Ottocento *Hard Times* uno dei romanzi più rappresentativi dei poderosi cambiamenti nel modo di produrre e di lavorare che vanno sotto il nome di rivoluzione industriale Esso pone al centro di uno sfaccettato intreccio narrativo la vita di patimenti e di impotente ribellione di due operai Stephen e Rachael non più giovanissimi La loro vita non vita si consuma nella simbolica Coketown una città fittizia dietro la quale occorre individuare per Preston vicino Manchester colta in un momento storico sociale determinato quello dei drammatici scioperi che vi ebbero luogo tra il 1853 e il 1854 Ma la rivoluzione industriale di cui l'Inghilterra protagonista e punta avanzata non si limita alle modalità di produzione i suoi effetti investono il modo di abitare e di divertirsi di amare di pensare di educare di organizzare e articolare lo Stato In *Hard Times* sullo sfondo ideologico dell'epoca dall'utilitarismo al pragmatismo al liberalismo si snoda così la vita dell'educatore Gradgrind e della sua famiglia del banchiere e industriale Bounderby dell'aristocratico e cinico Harthouse e di Sissy e Sleary appartenenti al mondo contrapposto ed emarginato del circo Operato da tali pensieri fino al punto da avere la terribile sensazione di non riuscire più a contenerli di trovarsi in una qualche nuova e corrotta relazione con le cose tra le quali passava e di vedere tingersi di rosso l'alone nebbioso di ogni lampione Stephen torna a casa per trovarvi riparo Charles Dickens nacque a Portsmouth nel 1812 Trascorse l'infanzia a Chatham e poi seguì il padre nel traumatico trasferimento a Londra Da allora la metropoli fu non solo la sua residenza abituale ma anche l'insostituibile centro ispiratore della sua arte Morì nel 1870 Di Dickens la Newton Compton ha pubblicato *David Copperfield* *Il Circolo Pickwick* *Le due città* *Racconti di Natale* e nella collana GTE *Oliver Twist* *Tempi difficili* e *Grandi speranze* **Hard Times** Charles Dickens, 1854 *The Reception of Charles Dickens in Europe* Michael Hollington, 2013-08-29 The Reception of Charles Dickens in Europe offers a full historical survey of Dickens's reception in all the major European countries and many of the smaller ones filling a major gap in Dickens scholarship which has by and large neglected Dickens's fortunes in Europe and his impact on major European authors and movements Essays by leading international critics and translators give full attention to cultural changes and fashions such as the decline of Dickens's fortunes at the end of the nineteenth century in the period of Naturalism and Aestheticism and the subsequent upswing in the period of Modernism in part as a consequence of the rise of film in the era of Chaplin and Eisenstein It will also offer accounts of Dickens's reception in periods of political upheaval and revolution such as during the communist era in Eastern Europe or under fascism in Germany and Italy in particular **Hard Times** Charles Dickens, 1927 Written deliberately to increase the circulation of Dickens's weekly magazine *Household Words* *Hard Times* was a huge and instantaneous success upon publication in 1854 Yet this novel is not the cheerful celebration of Victorian life one might have expected from the beloved author of *The Pickwick Papers* and *The Old Curiosity Shop* Compressed stark allegorical it is a bitter expose of capitalist exploitation during the industrial revolution and a fierce denunciation of the philosophy of

materialism which threatens the human imagination in all times and places With a typically unforgettable cast of characters including the heartless fact worshipper Mr Gradgrind the warmly endearing Sissy Jupe and the eternally noble Stephen Blackpool *Hard Times* carries a uniquely powerful message and remains one of the most widely read of Dickens's major novels *Tempi difficili. VV.,2011-02-08T00:00:00+01:00 1137 76 Hard Times Charles Dickens,2023-06-19 *Hard Times* originally *Hard Times* For These Times was published in 1854 and is the shortest novel Charles Dickens ever published It's set in Coketown a fictional mill town set in the north of England One of the major themes of the book is the miserable treatment of workers in the mills and the resistance to their unionization by the mill owners typified by the character Josiah Bounderby who absurdly asserts that the workers live a near idyllic life but they all expect to be set up in a coach and six and to be fed on turtle soup and venison with a gold spoon The truth of course is far different The other major topic which Dickens tackles in this novel is the rationalist movement in schooling and the denigration of imagination and fantasy It begins with the words Now what I want is Facts spoken by the wealthy magnate Thomas Gradgrind who is supervising a class at a model school he has opened This indeed is Gradgrind's entire philosophy Teach these boys and girls nothing but Facts Facts alone are wanted in life Plant nothing else and root out everything else He is supported and encouraged in this approach by his friend Bounderby Grandgrind raises his own children on these principles and as we discover in doing so blights their lives The novel also follows the story of a particular mill worker Stephen Blackpool who leads a tragic life He is burdened with an alcoholic slatternly wife who is mostly absent from his life but who returns at irregular intervals to trouble him This existing marriage and the near impossibility of divorce for someone of his class prevents him marrying Rachael who is the light of his life Dickens depicts Stephen as representing the nobility of honest work and contrasts his character with that of the self-satisfied humbug Josiah Bounderby who represents the worst aspects of capitalism **Quel che resta dei media** Gianfranco
