

Palmer, 1969 Hermeneutics introduces English speaking readers to a field of increasing importance in contemporary philosophy and theology hermeneutics the theory of understanding or interpretation Hermeneutics is concerned with the character of understanding especially as it is related to interpreting linguistic texts It goes beyond mere philological methodology however to questions of the philosophy of language the nature of historical understanding and ultimately the roots of interpretation in existential understanding Palmer principally treats the conception of hermeneutics enunciated by Heidegger and developed into a philosophical hermeneutics by Hans Georg Gadamer He provides a brief overview of the field of hermeneutics by surveying some half dozen alternate definitions of the term and by examining in detail the contributions of Friedrich Schleiermacher and Wilhelm Dilthey In the Manifesto which concludes the book Palmer suggests the potential significance of hermeneutics for literary interpretation When the context of interpretation is pressed to its limits hermeneutics becomes the philosophical analysis of what is involved in every act of understanding In this context hermeneutics becomes relevant not simply to the humanistic disciplines in which linguistic and historical understanding are crucial but to scientific forms of interpretation as well for it asserts the principles involved in any and every act of interpretation Hermeneutics Richard E.
