shipmate is his single handed attempt to transport a very large hog back to the ship After capturing the last American fort on the Pacific coast Joseph s ship sailed to Hawaii and Tahiti hunting American shipping Her mission completed Racoon once more rounded to the Horn and as a final duty escorted a convoy back to England Joseph s service was ended
