denounced Saigo as a rebel and a traitor but their propaganda could not overcome his fame and in 1889 twelve years after his death the government relented pardoned Saigo of all crimes and posthumously restored him to imperial court rank In THE LAST SAMURAI Saigo is as compelling a character as Robert E Lee was to Americans a great and noble warrior who followed the dictates of honor and loyalty even though it meant civil war in a country to which he d devoted his life Saigo s life is a fascinating look into Japanese feudal society and a history of a country as it struggled between its long traditions and the dictates of a modern future
