1. If $g(t) = 7e^{-0.2t+3}$ write out and simplify

(a) $g(3) = 7e^{-0.2} = 8.6387 \times 10^{-4}$

(b) $g(2-t) = 7e^{-0.2(2-t)+3} = 7e^{-0.4+2t+3} = 7e^{-2.6+2t}$

(c) $g(t/10+4) = 7e^{-0.2(t/10+4)+3}$

(d) $g(jt) = 7e^{-0.2jt+3}$

(e) $\frac{g(jt) + g(-jt)}{2} = 7e^{-3} \frac{e^{-j2t} + e^{j2t}}{2} = 7e^{-3} \cos(2t) = 0.3485 \cos(2t)$

(f) $\frac{g\left(\frac{jt-3}{2}\right) + g\left(\frac{-jt-3}{2}\right)}{2} = 7 \frac{e^{-j(2t-6)+3} + e^{j(2t-6)+3}}{2} = 7 \frac{e^{-j2t+6+3} + e^{j2t-6+3}}{2} = 7 \frac{e^{-j2t+9} + e^{j2t-3}}{2} = 7 \cos(2t)$
