Today, Barker, co-president of the Freedom From Religion Foundation Inc (www.ffrf.org), frequently represents freethought on the talkshow circuit and at personal appearances, concerts, and debates around the country, turning his experience as a former minister into ammunition against superstition and irrationality. In *Losing Faith in Faith*, Barker explains why he left the ministry. He also offers a definitive, compelling analysis of why he rejects belief in a god and the claims of religion. He explores the fallacies, inconsistencies, and harm of Christian doctrine and theistic dogma. In its place, he issues an appealing and compassionate invocation of freethought, reason, and humanism. *Losing Faith in Faith* is both a challenge to believers and an arsenal for skeptics.
