

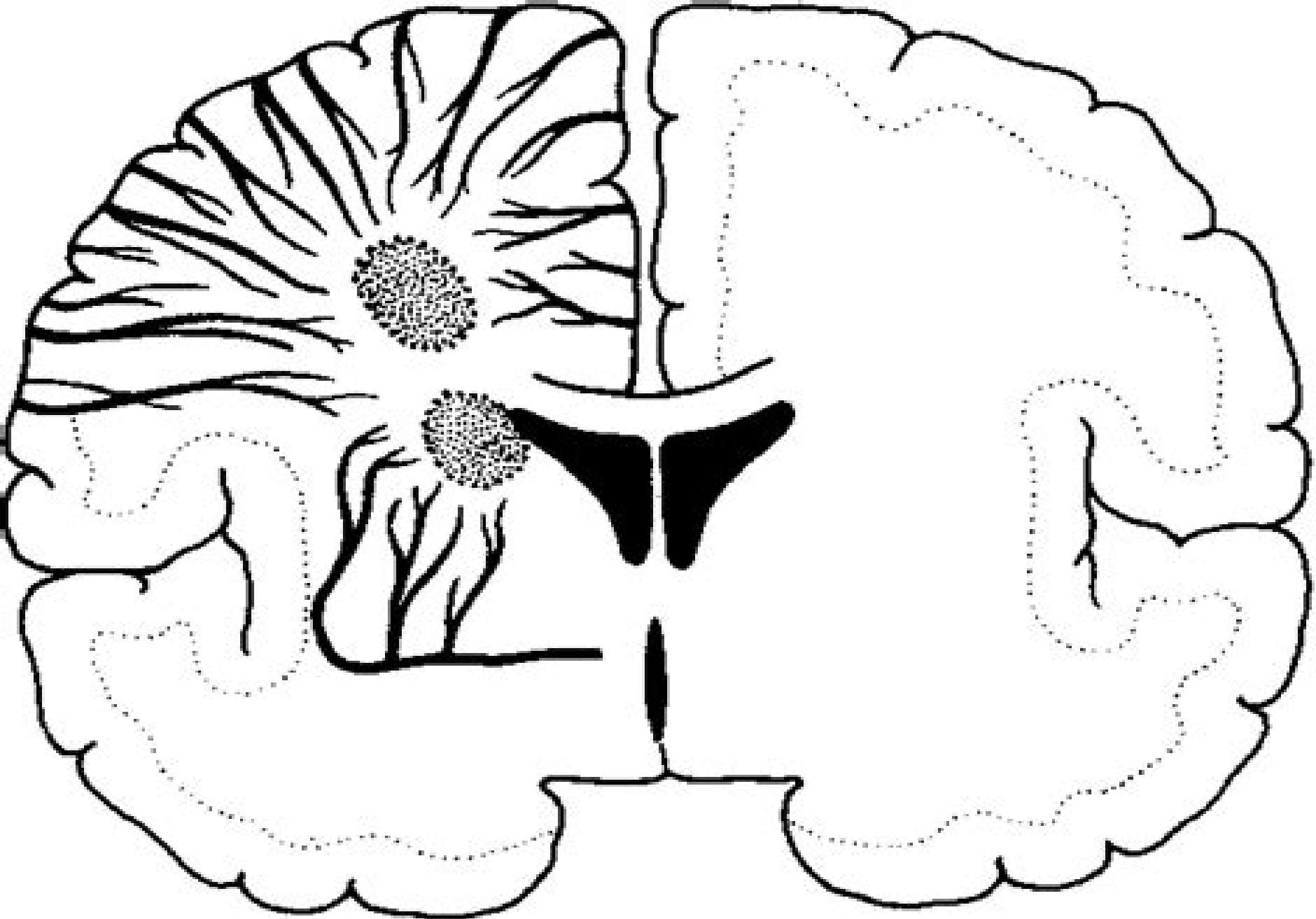


FIG 1. Schematic diagram showing the border zone between the deep perforators of the middle cerebral
