#### Uncertainty aversion in game theory: Experimental evidence

#### ABSTRACT

This paper studies, using a laboratory experiment, the effects of uncertainty aversion (the union of risk aversion and ambiguity aversion) on behavior in a normal form game. We isolate and identify two components of uncertainty aversion in games: the effect of an agent's own uncertainty preferences and effect of the agent's beliefs regarding their opponent's uncertainty preferences. Uncertainty preferences are correlated with behavior in games. Induced beliefs about the risk preferences of an opponent have a larger effect on strategic behavior than induced beliefs about an opponent's ambiguity preferences, although both components have a significant effect on behavior. The results support the hypothesis that strategic uncertainty is an important determinant of strategic behavior, and that the response to strategic uncertainty is modulated by subject uncertainty attitudes.

#### 1. Introduction

Strategic uncertainty is a ubiquitous feature of human interaction. Whether playing rock-paper-scissors, taking a penalty shot in soccer, playing poker, negotiating a pay raise or purchasing a house, certainty about an opponent's strategy is a rarity. A wealth of experiments on individual decision making have found that human subjects have non-neutral attitudes towards uncertainty, with a majority of subjects typically displaying either risk or ambiguity aversion. Therefore, understanding the relationship between preferences over uncertainty and strategic behavior is necessary for understanding human behavior in sames.

There is, however, a relative paucity of experimental studies on the role of risk and ambiguity aversion in game theoretic environments, perhaps reflecting the minor role of uncertainty aversion in the game theory literature (see Section 1.2 for a literature review). This paper asks two fundamental questions. Are there differences in behavior in strategic settings between people who are uncertainty averse and those who are not? And, do people change their behavior in strategic settings when
