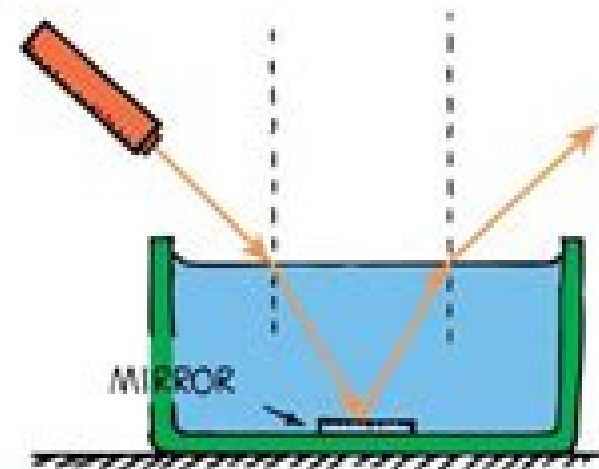


Refraction

perturbation leads to a response induced field of the system The dielectric function ratio between the induced and the external field is thus a response function The dielectric functions of various materials such as water and metals are discussed in detail A final part discusses basic elements of optics including Huygens principle interference diffraction refraction and reflection

The Elements of Physics Edward Leamington Nichols, William Suddards Franklin, 1903 *Waiting for the East Wind* Elise Van Loon, This dissertation explains stick charts from the Marshall Islands and how each one is unique to the navigator who created it Stick charts are navigational tools that map the ocean's geography by illustrating how the atolls interrupt the ocean swells without giving any significant detail to the landmasses themselves Examining these instruments may lead to an understanding of how the Marshallese people perceive maritime space The stick charts are frequently compared to cartesian maps and the physical geography of the area However as time is a large factor in sailing I examined the varied elements of several stick charts as a matter of time rather than space The geographic distance between two atolls is constant but the placement of the atolls on each chart fluctuates The possibility for the different placements is due to the influences of the sea causing an outward journey to take more or less time than the return Through investigating the charts and linking elements of seafaring the artefacts may convey abstract illustrations or literal representations of their environment This dissertation aims to not only analyse the Marshallese stick charts but to collate components of their culture and heritage in order to explain the environment these charts were used in This supports the idea that maritime space can be derived from how these charts were created Based on each person's view of the sea the information they deliver will be built on perception of time distance and obstacles

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Will Winn has written *Introduction to Understandable Physics* with the goal of presenting physics in a building block fashion Accordingly Volume III Electricity Magnetism and Light requires a knowledge of Volume I Mechanics and Volume II Matter Heat and Waves Volume III begins with a study of electric charges their electric fields forces and subsequently their motion as electric currents These currents are shown to produce magnetic fields forces where electromagnets are studied as models for understanding permanent magnets Next The reverse process where magnetic fields produce current is examined and applied for generating electricity AC and DC circuits exemplify further applications Finally electric and magnetic fields are found to produce electromagnetic waves that move at the speed of light The study of light begins with historical measurements of its speed and then examines its electromagnetic power intensity light spectra human response and color perception Next light reflection and refraction are applied to mirrors lenses rainbows eyeglasses telescopes and microscopes Subsequently The text examines the wave nature of light As exhibited by its diffraction and interference phenomena Furthermore when the electric field amplitudes of waves are oriented along one dimension light is polarized Polaroids filter out such glaring light when used in sunglasses Finally various light experiments provided early clues for discovering relativity and quantum mechanics which are examined in Volume IV Near the end of each chapter a Simple Projects section suggests experiments and or field trips that can reinforce the physics covered Some experiments are simple enough for students to explore alone while others benefit from equipment available to physics instructors Also optional text sections provide students with a deeper appreciation of the subject matter however these are not required for continuity Some of these optional topics can be candidates for term projects **Reader's Guide to Periodical Literature Supplement** ,1919
