Lemmo, 2001 A world history textbook chronicling the rise of Western and Eastern civilizations Includes photos art illustrated charts vocabulary exercises and review questions *Allegories of Empire* Jenny Sharpe, *Allegories of Empire* was first published in 1993 *Allegories of Empire* reconstellates a metropolitan masterpiece Forster's *A Passage to India* within colonial discourse studies Sharpe a materialist feminist is scrupulous in her use of theory to articulate nationalism historical race gendering and contemporary feminist critique Gayatri Chakravorty Spivak Columbia University Jenny Sharpe has done a great service in opening up the virtually taboo subject of the rape of the white woman by the colored man and furthermore in teaching us theory making by locating this frenzy of fantasy and reality within a specific crisis of European colonialism in India In showing how a wild anthropology must continuously rework feminism in the face of racism and vice versa she shows how the margins of empire were and still are at its center Michael Taussig New York University *Allegories of Empire* introduces race and colonialism to feminist theories of rape and sexual difference deploying women's writing to undo the appropriation of English universal womanhood for the perpetuation of Empire Sharpe brings the historical memory of the 1857 Indian Mutiny to bear upon the theme of rape in British and Anglo Indian fiction She argues that the idea of Indian men raping white women was not part of the colonial landscape prior to the revolt that was remembered as the savage attack of mutinous Indian soldiers on defenseless English women By showing how contemporary theories of female agency are implicated in an imperial past Sharpe argues that such models are inappropriate not only for discussion of colonized women but for European women as well Ultimately she insists that feminist theory must begin from difference and dislocation rather than from identity and correspondence if it is to get beyond the race gender class impasse Jenny Sharpe received her Ph D in comparative literature at the University of Texas at Austin and is currently a professor of English at the University of California at Los Angeles She has contributed articles to *Modern Fiction Studies* *Genders* and *boundary 2* World History: Connections to Today Prentice Hall (School Division), Prentice Hall Dictionary Editors, 2001-06 To purchase or download a workbook click on the Purchase or Download button to the left To purchase a workbook enter the desired quantity and click Add to Cart To download a free workbook right click the FREE Download PDF link and save to your computer This will result in a faster download as opposed to left clicking and opening the link *Herbert Croly's The Promise of American Life at Its Centenary* John Allphin Moore, 2009-05-27 As of 2005 Herbert Croly's *The Promise of American Life* first published in 1909 had gone through eleven different printings from a variety of publishing houses suggesting its enduring stature as an American classic The book had an acknowledged influence on early to mid twentieth century American politics and political thought Theodore Roosevelt read the book after he left the White House and when he decided to run for another term as president in 1912 used Croly's themes in his campaign After Willard and Dorothy Straight

read the book they contacted Croly and brought him together with Walter Lippmann and Walter Weyl to edit the journal they founded in 1914 *The New Republic*. In 1961 Charles Forcey announced in *The Crossroads of Liberalism* that Croly's *Promise of American Life* of 1909 has become the prevailing political faith of most Americans. Following Franklin Roosevelt's Croly-inspired New Deal, the New Frontier, and the Great Society of John Kennedy and Lyndon Johnson seemed by the 1960s to have confirmed Forcey's assessment and thus Croly's ascendant place in American politics. While the rise of a notable conservative backlash to American liberalism dimmed Croly's reputation by the end of the century, his book has continued to be part of the canon, often studied in college seminars, and even today his name surfaces in public policy discussions. This anthology analyzing *The Promise* at its 100th birthday presents essays by historians, political scientists, an economist, and an international relations scholar discussing the impact of Croly's book on twentieth-century America and opining on the suitability of *The Promise*'s ideas for the twenty-first century.
