1. Nature and Function of a State and its relationship with Law

It is difficult to give a precise definition of state because different political thinkers and jurists have defined it in different ways.

Salmond- "State as an association, of human beings established for the attainment of certain ends by certain means".

<u>Goodhart</u>- "The purpose of State is to maintain peace and order within a particular society. Therefore, the most essential purpose of state is to make life possible."

<u>Aristotle</u> - "State is a union of families and villages having for its end, a perfect and self-sufficing life, by which we mean happy and honourable life".

Woodrow Wilson- "State denotes a set of people organized for law within a definite territory".

Oppenheim- "a State comes into existence when people are settled in a country under its own sovereign government".

<u>Dallas</u>- "a State is a body of free persons, united together for the common benefit to enjoy peaceably what is their own, and to do justice to others".
