Martinko, 2017 To combat the spread of fake news researchers and academics point to historical thinking as a possible solution While generally researched in terms of formal education historical thinking is also being considered in history museums This research examined the ways in which children engage in historical thinking in history museums hands on spaces using Peter Seixas 2007 2015 six historical thinking concepts The researcher video recorded the interactions of 29 children between 8 12 years old in hands on spaces in three history museums Results showed that children engaged in
