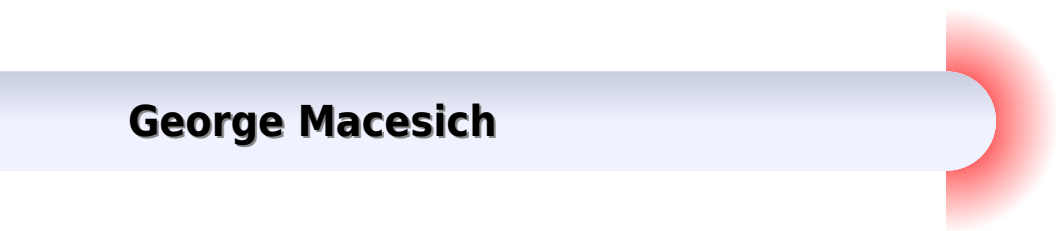

reproduction This feminist reinterpretation of our past holds profound implications for today's efforts to develop a more humane and sustainable form of capitalism
