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reproduite sont pour la première fois réunis ici. Accompagnés d'un appareil critique destiné aux chercheurs, aux étudiants, aux enseignants, aux fervents d'Apollinaire, aux amoureux de la poésie voire aux collectionneurs, ils constituent l'apogée d'un livre laborieusement élaboré pendant la Grande Guerre. Solidaires de cette Histoire vécue par le poète combattant, ils sont surtout un moment essentiel de l'histoire de l'art et de la poésie modernes. L'inventeur en 1917 du mot calligramme a créé dès 1914 dans ses poèmes formels une poésie spectaculaire qui s'offre simultanément à la lecture et à la contemplation. Apollinaire nous propose dans *Calligrammes* trop longtemps restés dans l'ombre d'Alcools toutes sortes de fantasmagoriques transformations poétiques dont l'héritage est loin d'être puisé. Présentées et analysées par Claude Debon, les tapes de cette création mettent en lumière un exceptionnel champ d'expérimentations et de réussites poétiques. **Canadian Review of Comparative Literature**, 1998

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
