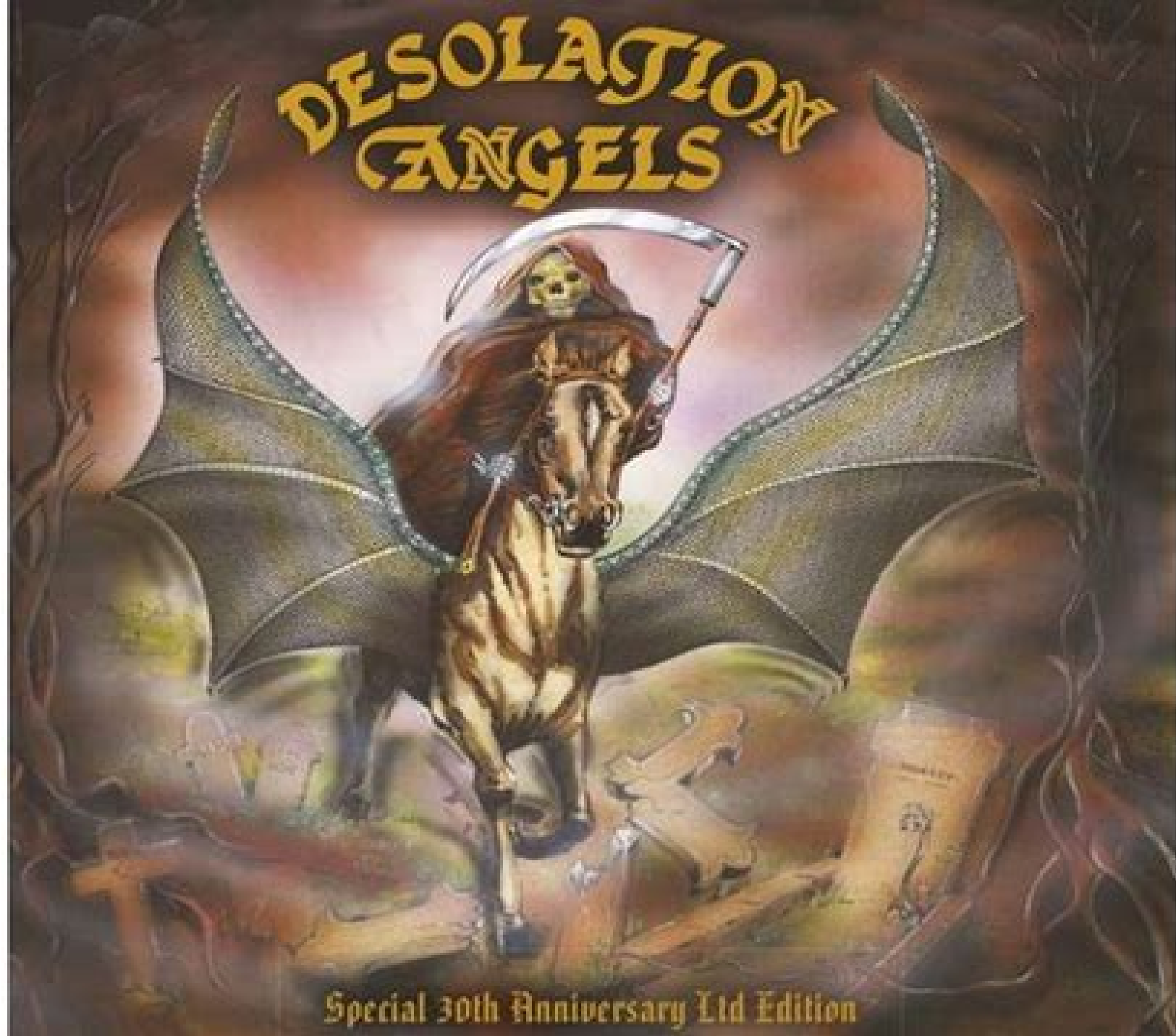

Desolation Angels Jack Kerouac, 1955-09-01 The classic autobiographical novel one of the most true comic and grizzly journeys in American literature Time from acclaimed author Jack Kerouac If the Pulitzer Prize were given for the book that is most representative of American life I would nominate Desolation Angels Dan Wakefield The Atlantic Desolation Angels covers a key year in Jack Kerouac's life the period that led up to the publication of *On the Road* in September of 1957 After spending two months in the summer of 1956 as a fire lookout on Desolation Peak in the North Cascade Mountains of Washington Kerouac's fictional self Jack Duluoz comes down from the isolated mountains to the wild excitement of the bars jazz clubs and parties of San Francisco before traveling on to Mexico City New York Tangiers Paris and London Duluoz attempts to extricate himself from the world but fails for one must live travel adventure bliss and don't be sorry Desolation Angels is quintessential Kerouac
