- There are two types of binary choice modes
 - 1) Logit regression
 - 2) Probit regression
- Nonlinear models for binary response
 - Response probability is a nonlinear function of explainatory variables

$$P(y=1|\mathbf{x}) = G(\beta_0 + \beta_1 x_1 + \ldots + \beta_k x_k) = G(\mathbf{x}\beta)$$

Probability of a "success" given explanatory variables A cumulative distribution function 0 < G(z) < 1 The response probability is thus a function of the explanatory variables x.

Shorthand vector notation: the vector of explanatory variables x also contains the constant of the model.
