indicator of parergonality and on the other the prime signal for a potential conditioning of the reader As readers we not only have to analyze the interaction between work and parergon but must also constantly reflect upon our own position with regard to the text that we read By means of the concept of the parergon we can approach not only paratextual narrative or discursive frames but also intertextual relationships Since the application of the concept is based on a basic textual constellation and an internal mechanism its range is wide and transcends or complements previously established textual categories
