#### Introduction to Morphology

- **Morphology** is concerned with the internal structure of words and the rules for forming words from their subparts, which are called **morphemes**.

- **Morphemes** are the smallest units in the structural analysis of words.

- It is often said that morphemes are the smallest units of meaning, but this is not quite accurate. They are the smallest structural units the learner identifies; to be identified as such a morpheme must have an identifiable grammatical behavior, but not necessarily an identifiable meaning.

- Although we know that the subparts of these words once had constant meanings (L *trāns* 'across', *per* 'through', *cum* 'with', *mitt-ere* 'to send') the learner of contemporary English does not know this (ordinarily).
- In any case the words don't mean 'send across, send, through, send with'
- However, the root [mit] shows an identifiable constant grammatical **behavior**: it changes to [miss] when the verb is used to make the corresponding noun through suffixation of [-ion]

In general these require more research or analysis beyond what can be accomplished within a single classroom period. These exploratory exercises can also form the basis for short papers. Therefore the book can be of immense help not only to students of linguistics and translation but also to professors of linguistics and translation and research supervisors as well as
