Usually a novel contains a beginning a middle and an end That is what the reader expects from the majority of books This convention is not only based on the presumption that only by this sequence of beginning middle and end a reader will find the reading of a novel rewarding but there are also theoretical concepts demanding this structure Mendilow points out that Aristotle was one of the first to stress the meaning of a general structure in a piece of literature According to Aristotle *ein Ganzes ist was Anfang Mitte und Ende hat Ein Anfang ist was selbst nicht mit Notwendigkeit auf etwas anderes folgt nach dem jedoch natürlichlicherweise etwas anderes eintritt oder entsteht Ein Ende ist umgekehrt was selbst natürlichlicherweise auf etwas anderes folgt und zwar notwendigerweise oder in der Regel während nach ihm nichts anderes mehr eintritt Eine Mitte ist was sowohl selbst auf etwas anderes folgt als auch etwas anderes nach sich zieht* This concept is true for realistic novels but it falls short for most of the postmodern novels In this paper I will show how the structure of a linear plot is given up in Peter Ackroyd's novel *Hawksmoor* The sequence of beginning middle and end evokes that all events are linked by a chain of causality In *Hawksmoor* the chain of causality and the linear concept of time are replaced by a circular concept of time The events in the novel and in particular the murders cannot be explained by the principle of causality In my paper I will analyse the concept of time in Ackroyd's novel As a first step I will point out the relation of the novel to the historical figure Nicholas Hawksmoor and summarise briefly the two plots so that on this basis the analogies and recurrences in each plot can be better understood Chapter 3 deals with the conception of characters because it is the repetition of characteristics biographies and attitudes of the characters that illustrate best the linear concept of time The character that is associated the most with this concept of time is the protagonist of the eighteenth century plot Nicholas Dyer Therefore I choose this figure for a detailed analysis in chapter 4

and identity both in his fiction and non fiction The London of his novels is thus a highly idiosyncratic construct which reflects and derives from its author s ideas about the actual city s nature as well as his concept of the English literary sensibility in general as he outlines them in his lectures and historical and literary studies It is an exceptionally heterogeneous city of enormous diversity and richness of human experience moods and emotion of actions and events and also of the tools through which these are re presented and reenacted According to Ackroyd this heterogeneity mostly originates outside the sites and domains of the established or mainstream cultural production and social norms and conventions particularly in occult practices subversive acts and the plotting of radical individuals or groups criminal and fraudulent activities of various kinds dubious scientific experiments and the popular dramatic forms of ritual and entertainment whose permanent encounters with and contesting of the officially approved and prescribed forms instigate the city s vitalising energy for dynamic change and spiritual renewal This book presents the world of Ackroyd s London novels as a distinct chronotope determined by specific spatial and temporal properties and their mutual interconnectedness Although such a concept of urban space in its essence defies categorisation the book is thematically organised around six defining aspects of the city as Ackroyd identifies them the relationship between its past and present its uncanny manifestations its felonious tendencies its inhabitants
