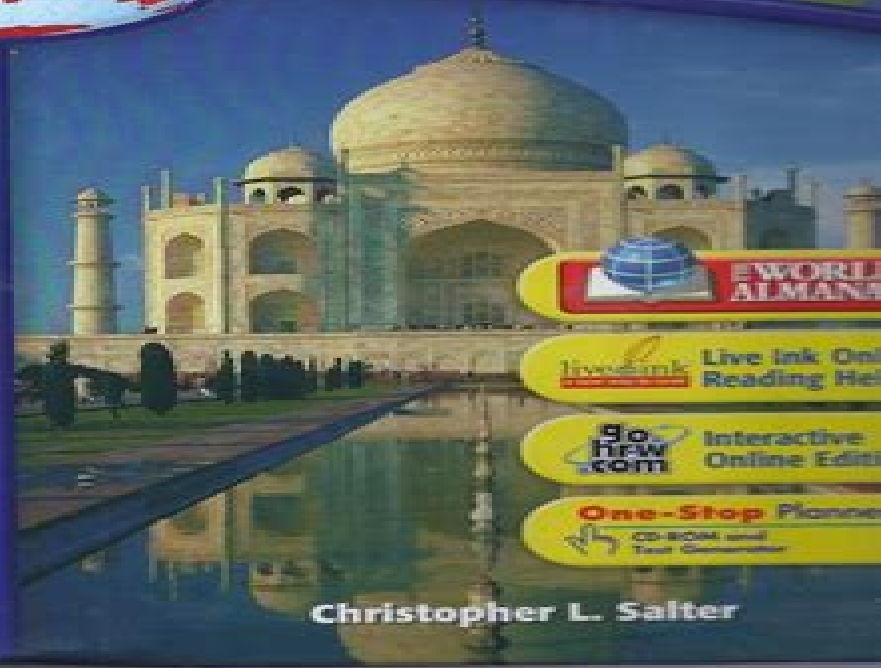

political communication theory to democratic practice The authors also critique leadership studies using Lasswell s concerns over the risks to democratic accountability and the current preoccupation with strengthening the roles of charismatic and transformational leaders Intended for researchers practitioners and students in the areas of political and historical psychology political strategy and political communication the book s emphasis on psychodynamics also appeals to psychoanalysts and the material on leadership appeals to professionals in management and industrial organizational psychology
