1. the study of biological inheritance patterns and variation in organisms

3. Mendel recognized that traits are inherited as discrete units, whereas many others believed that traits were mixed together.
4. control over breeding; removed the stamens and fertilized the plant with pollen from a pea plant of his choice
5. use of purebred plants; used self-pollinating, purebred pea plants
6. studied "either-or" traits; looked at traits that did not have intermediate characteristics such as pea shape, pea color, flower color, pod shape, pod color, flower position, and plant height
7. Pea plants reproduce quickly, and he could control how they mate.
8. Box 2: Allowed F₁ offspring to self-pollinate. Box 4: Calculated the phenotypic ratios in the F₂ generation.
