

1. Diary, Jan van Riebeeck

Krotoa, called Eva by the Dutch, is the first Khoikhoi woman to appear in the European records of the early settlement at the Cape as an individual personality and active participant in cultural and economic exchange. Eva joined Commander Jan van Riebeeck's household at the Dutch fort at around age 12. She was closely related to Oedasoa, chief of the Cochoqua Khoikhoi, but it is unclear whether her family sent her to the Dutch to work and learn the language or whether she made this decision on her own. She learned to speak fluent Dutch and Portuguese, and acted as an interpreter for the Dutch for most of her life. She converted to Christianity and in 1664 married a Danish surgeon, Pieter van Meerhoff, who was rising in the service of the Dutch East India Company. Together they had three children. After his death on an expedition to Madagascar, Eva became an alcoholic and was eventually sent to the prison colony on Robben Island for disorderly conduct. She died in 1674 and was given a Christian burial.

The following selections are from the official diary kept by the Dutch Commander Jan van Riebeeck and his council at the Cape. Since these men were representatives of a major trading company, most entries have something to do with commercial interests. Eva emerges as a savvy business partner to the Dutch, but also as a person truly suspended between two cultures. Note her use of clothing, religion, and language as she negotiates between the Dutch and the Khoikhoi worlds.

31 October 1657:

"The Commander [Jan van Riebeeck] spent the day entertaining the Saldanhars [a Khoikhoi tribe from the interior] and questioning them about various things through the medium of a certain girl, aged 15 or 16, and by us called Eva, who has been in the service of the Commander's wife from the beginning and is now living here permanently and is beginning to speak Dutch well."

21 June 1658:

"Fine weather with N.W. breeze. The freeman Jan Reijnierssen came to complain early in the morning that during the night all his male and female slaves had run away, taking with them 3 or 4 blankets, clothing, rice, tobacco, etc. We thereupon called the new interpreter Doman, now called Anthony, who had returned from Batavia with the Hon. Cuneus, and asked him why the Hottentots would not search for the runaway slaves, to which he coolly replied that he did not know. [Little is known about Doman, though he was one of the important interpreters between the Dutch and the Khoikhoi in the early years. He was taken to Batavia (now Jakarta, Indonesia) to learn Dutch, and there he seems to have noticed the threat that the Dutch posed to indigenous ways of life. When he returned to the Cape, he consistently advocated Khoikhoi interests, especially of the Peninsular tribes, over those of the Dutch in trade negotiations.] The Commander, not trusting him, then called the interpreter Eva alone into his office and privately asked her whether our blacks were not being harboured by the Hottentots. On this she asked

Current Projects in Historical Lexicography John Considine, 2010-04-16 Current Projects in Historical Lexicography brings together seven papers by present and recent editors of historical dictionaries and lexical databases. The collection is introduced with an overview of the history of historical lexicography from the ancient world to the present day with particular emphasis on the major nineteenth century dictionaries of German, French, English, Dutch, Swedish and Danish and on their successors. In the first paper Javier Mart n Arista describes the present state of and the prospects for the Nerthus lexical database of Old English. The next two introduce specialized dictionaries of the language of medieval and early modern texts. Fernando Tejedo Herrero's comprehensive dictionary of the language of the great thirteenth century lawcode Siete Partidas and Juhani Norri's Dictionary of Medical Vocabulary in English 1375-1530. Marijke Mooijaart's paper discusses the online integration of the four historical dictionaries which cover Dutch from the earliest times to the twentieth century. The next two papers, Stefan Dollinger on the Dictionary of Canadianisms on Historical Principles and the Bank of Canadian English and Maggie Scott on the Concise Scots Dictionary, describe projects to revise twentieth century historical dictionaries as the language varieties which they register evolve. Finally, Jeremy Bergerson's paper presents a project for an etymologically rich historical dictionary of Afrikaans. An appendix to the volume comprises two previously unpublished short documents by Katherine Barber and John Considine which bear on the history of the Dictionary of Canadianisms revision project. The contributions to this volume offer a rare set of insights into ongoing lexicographical work addressing both methodological issues such as inclusion criteria and the balance between diachronic and synchronic coverage and practical issues such as publication media and funding.

Apartheid's Festival Leslie Witz, 2003-10-06 Apartheid's Festival highlights the conflicts and debates that surrounded the 1952 celebration of the 300th anniversary of the landing of Jan Van Riebeeck and the founding of Cape Town, South Africa. Taking place at the height of the apartheid era, the festival was viewed by many as an opportunity for the government to promote its nationalist separatist agenda in grand fashion. Leslie Witz's fine-grained examination of newspapers, brochures, pamphlets and advertising materials reveals the expectations of the festival planners as well as how the festival was engineered. Historical figures were reconstructed and the ANC and other anti-apartheid organizations mounted opposition to it. While laying open the darker motives of the apartheid regime, Witz shows that the production of local history is part of a global process forged by the struggle between colonialism and resistance. Readers interested in South Africa, representations of nationalism and the making of public history will find Apartheid's Festival to be an important study of a society in transition.

Diary of an African Journey H. Rider Haggard, 2001-08 In 1914 Haggard, the author of colonialist novels King Solomon's Mines and She, returned to South Africa which had greatly changed since the first visits of his youth. This account of his journey as a member of the British Empire's Dominions Royal Commission offers observations on the changed nature of the country after

the Anglo Boer wars and details a number of aspects of the political landscape including a description of his interview with the founder of the African National Congress John Dube c Book News Inc **The Stolen Bible** Gerald O. Johannes Meintjes Diaries , 2024-09-25 The artist Johannes Petrus Meintjes 19 May 1923 to 7 July 1980 was also a historian and author Spanning a period of almost 40 years his body of autobiographical work includes thirteen diaries Considered Africana Meintjes self published the first four volumes three Diaries and Jeugjare through his Bamboesberg Publishers His first diary entry was on 13 February 1941 while the last entry was recorded in 5 July 1980 two days prior to his death The various diaries published and unpublished represent a collected work that tells the story of Johannes Meintjes life as an artist and author This includes inscriptions on people he met comments about political events as well as matters of faith In this English synopsis 424 pages illustrated with examples of his artistic output the compilers steered clear of deeply personal nonsensical or malicious comments while toning down accounts of his extensive social activities There are references to health or financial issues that affected Meintjes creativity and the experience of pain and sadness is also touched upon briefly where appropriate In the end it was Meintjes entry on 30 January 1964 When I started on the Diary I never realised that it would become my monument If it were ever to appear as a single volume who knows it can be cut drastically that served as catalyst and inspiration culminating in the Afrikaans publication of the Johannes Meintjes Dagboeke launched at the Stellenbosch University Museum in 2023 a century after his birth Publishing a synopsis of all thirteen diaries into one single volume was a project that took more than ten years It was spearheaded by Lydia de Waal a previous Director of the Stellenbosch University Museum and assisted by Kobus Opperman the Johannes Meintjes Archivist Associate Professor Emeritus at Stellenbosch University Dr Edwin Hees translated the document into English Mr Bongani Mgijia the Director of the Stellenbosch University Museum graciously arranged for sponsoring this translation Amanda Botha seasoned arts journalist ends the book with her valued conclusion The Meintjes Diaries Mirror and Reflection The English translation contains additional archival material kindly made available by the Meintjes family from their personal collection *The*
