When the threat to the principal or the costs to the agent increase, the principal responds with higher-powered incentives and the proxy responds with greater effort. If interests diverge too much, the principal must either take direct action or admit that indirect control is unworkable. Covering events from Denmark under the Nazis to the Korean War to contemporary Afghanistan and much in between, the chapters in Proxy Wars engage many disciplines and will suit classes taught in political science, economics, international relations, security studies and much more.
