Red Dust Jian Ma, 2002 Part memoir part travelogue this volume shows Ma Jian's skills as novelist poet and painter It brings the people and places alive on the page while his personal story offers an insight into Chinese society since the death Red Dust Ma Jian, 2002-11-12 In 1983 at the age of thirty dissident artist Ma Jian finds himself divorced by his of Mao wife separated from his daughter betrayed by his girlfriend facing arrest for Spiritual Pollution and severely disillusioned with the confines of life in Beijing So with little more than a change of clothes and two bars of soap Ma takes off to immerse himself in the remotest parts of China His journey would last three years and take him through smog choked cities and mountain villages from scenes of barbarity to havens of tranquility Remarkably written and subtly moving the result is an insight into the teeming contradictions of China that only a man who was both insider and outsider in his own country could have written The Dark Road Ma Jian, 2013-06-13 From one of world literature s most courageous voices a novel about the human cost of China's one child policy through the lens of one rural family on the run from its reach Far away from the Chinese economic miracle from the bright lights of Beijing and Shanghai is a vast rural hinterland where life goes on much as it has for generations with one extraordinary difference normal parents are permitted by the state to have only a single child The Dark Road is the story of one such normal family Meili a young peasant woman her husband Kongzi a village schoolteacher and their daughter Nannan Kongzi is according to family myth a direct lineal descendant of Confucius and he is haunted by the imperative to carry on the family name by having a son And so Meili becomes pregnant again without state permission and when local family planning officials launch a new wave of crackdowns the family makes the radical decision to leave its village and set out on a small rickety houseboat down the Yangtze River Theirs is a dark road and tragedy awaits them and horror but also the fierce beauty born of courageous resistance to injustice and inhumanity The Dark Road is a haunting and indelible portrait of the tragedies befalling women and families at the hands of China's one child policy and of the human spirit's capacity to endure even the most brutal cruelty While Ma Jian wrote The Dark Road he traveled through the rural backwaters of southwestern China to see how the state enforced the one child policy far from the outside world s prying eyes He met local women who had been seized from their homes and forced to undergo abortions or sterilization in the policy s name and on the Yangtze River he lived among fugitive couples who had gone on the run so they could have more children that most fundamental of human rights Like all of Ma Jian's novels The Dark Road is also a celebration of the life force of the often comically stubborn resilience of man s most basic instincts China's Three Gorges, Xi'an and the Terracotta Warriors Simon Foster, Vivien Lougheed, 2009-10-15 This guide is based on our much larger 530 page guide to Bolivia Here we zero in on La Paz the capital and all of the nearby attractions La Paz is not a big city on the world scale but it is certainly one of the more interesting ones Built in a bowl created by the Choqueyapu River the upper parts of the city stand 1 645 ft 500 m above the lower sections Unlike any other city in the world the richer neighborhoods are located at the

lower levels. This is partly due to the fact that it is warmer and easier to breathe at the lower altitudes. Also the pinnacles and spires of conglomerate rock and clay that have been sculptured by wind and water make a dramatic backdrop for those living below them The higher up the bowl one goes the more unstable the land becomes and the more likely a landslide will occur The plazas squares and Prado are well kept in La Paz and even in the depth of winter plants are tended to help make the city attractive Street cleaners are out every day and local merchants regularly wash the area in front of their shops On a clear day Mount Illimani a snow covered monolith can be seen as a sentry towering over the city Valley of the Moon is six miles 10 km from the center of La Paz and can be reached by joining a tour or by taking micro bus 11 or minibus 231 or 273 to Mallasilla The hillside features a maze of clay canyons and pinnacles that have been sculpted by wind and rain Narrow trails through the landscape take about an hour to walk There is also a cactus park just before the entrance The park overlooks a gorge and has paths leading around numerous types of cacti As you continue up the road you will come to Parque National Mallasa with its bird observatory and across the road the zoo area.
