

The quality of the calculation also depends on the choice of differencing interval of the time series The calculation of downside risk assumes that financial time series follow either a normal or lognormal distribution Finally there is no universal risk measure for the many broad categories of risk For example standard deviation captures the risk of not achieving the mean beta captures the risk of investing
