Satantango László Krasznahorkai, 2012-03-05 From the winner of the 2015 Man Booker International Prize At long last twenty five years after the Hungarian genius L szl Krasznahorkai burst onto the scene with his first novel Satantango dances into English in a beautiful translation by George Szirtes Already famous as the inspiration for the filmmaker B la Tarr s six hour masterpiece Satantango is proof as the spellbinding bleak and hauntingly beautiful book has it that the devil has all the good times The story of Satantango spread over a couple of days of endless rain focuses on the dozen remaining inhabitants of an unnamed isolated hamlet failures stuck in the middle of nowhere Schemes crimes infidelities hopes of escape and above all trust and its constant betrayal are Krasznahorkai s meat At the center of Satantango George Szirtes has said is the eponymous drunken dance referred to here sometimes as a tango and sometimes as a csardas It takes place at the local inn where everyone is drunk Their world is rough and ready lost somewhere between the comic and tragic in one small insignificant corner of the cosmos Theirs is the dance of death You know Mrs Schmidt a pivotal character tipsily confides dance is my one weakness **Satantango** László Krasznahorkai, Anamaria Pop, 2012 **Satantango** Laszlo
