Victor falls ill for 2 months. Upon recovery, he returns to Geneva and marries Elisabeth. On their wedding night, the Monster kills the bride. Victor's father dies a few days later.



Chapters 1-2

Frankenstein tells about his family and his early years in Geneva. He describes Henry Clerval and Elizabeth Lavenza, his childhood companions.



Chapters 6-10

Victor's younger brother, William, is killed. Victor is sure that the monster is the one to blame. In Geneva, Victor goes to the mountains and meets the creature.



Chapters 18-20

Victor heads for England, accompanied by Henry Clerval. On a desolate island, he creates the female creature but then destroys it. The monster kills Henry in revenge.



Chapter 24
