concept are the following i In extensive form games a Nash strategy may prescribe off the equilibrium path behavior that is manifestly irrational Specifically Nash equilibria may involve incredible threats ii Nash equilibria need not be robust with respect to small perturbations in the data of the game Confronted with the growing evidence to the detriment of the Nash concept game theorists were prompted to search for more refined equilibrium notions with better properties and they have come up with a wide array of alternative solution concepts This book surveys the most important refinements that have been introduced Its objectives are fourfold i to illustrate desirable properties as well as drawbacks of the various equilibrium notions by means of simple specific examples ii to study the relationships between the various refinements iii to derive simplifying characterizations and iv to discuss the plausibility of the assumptions underlying the concepts
