7. How did Victor's mother die?

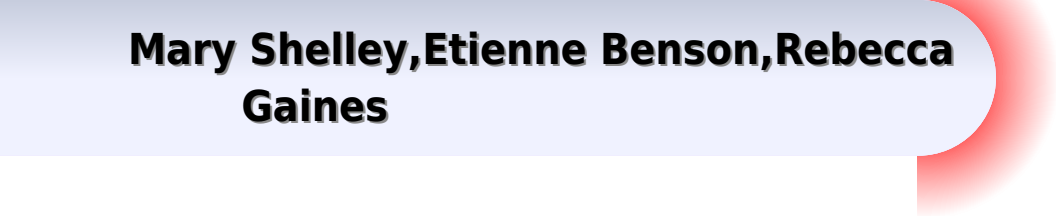
After nursing Elizabeth through scarlet fever, Victor's mother herself caught it and died.
