Franz Liszt Michael Saffle, 2013-02-01 *Franz Liszt A Research and Information Guide* is an annotated bibliography concerning both the nature of primary sources related to the composer and the scope and significance of the secondary sources which deal with him his compositions and his influence as a composer and performer The second edition includes research published since the publication of the first edition and provide electronic resources Franz Liszt was born on 22 October 1811 at Raiding today located in Austria s Burgenland He received his first piano lessons from his father Adam Liszt an employee of the celebrated Eszterhazy family Young Franz was quickly acclaimed a prodigy and in 1820 a group of Hungarian magnates offered to underwrite his musical education Shortly thereafter the Liszts moved to Vienna where Franz studied piano and composition with Carl Czerny and Anton Salieri Performances there earned Liszt local fame even Beethoven expressed interest in him [The Music of Franz Liszt](#) Michael Saffle, 2018-04-09 Much of Franz Liszt s musical legacy has often been dismissed as trivial or merely showy more or less peripheral contributions to nineteenth century European culture But Liszt was a mainstream composer in ways most of his critics have failed to acknowledge he was also an incessant and often extremely successful innovator Liszt s mastery of fantasy and sonata traditions his painstaking settings of texts ranging from erotic verse to portions of the Catholic liturgy and the remarkable self awareness he demonstrated even in many of his most entertaining pieces all these things stamp him not only as a master of Romanticism and an early Impressionist but as a precursor of Postmodern pop Liszt s Music places Liszt in historical and cultural focus At the same time it examines his principal contributions to musical literature from his earliest operatic paraphrases to his final explorations of harmonic and formal possibilities Liszt s compositional methods including his penchant for revision problems associated with early editions of some of his works and certain aspects of class and gender issues are also discussed The first book length assessment of Liszt as composer since Humphrey Searle s 1956 volume *Liszt s Music* is illustrated with well over 100 musical examples [Liszt Ferenc: A Complete Thematic Catalogue](#) Leslie Howard, Minkyu Kim [□□□], Aidan Módica, Michael Short, 2025-02-20 The first catalogues of Liszt s uvre were published during his own lifetime In 1855 the *Thematisches Verzeichniss* appeared in print but this included only a selection of his published works An expanded version was issued in 1877 although it was still missing many published compositions After Liszt s death in 1886 it took a long time for there to be any serious scholarship focused on cataloguing the vast quantity of music by this prolific composer The German composer Peter Raabe compiled the first exhaustive work list in 1931 revised by Felix Raabe in 1968 In England Humphrey Searle s 1954 catalogue for Grove s Dictionary of Music introduced S numbers which neatly organised Liszt s works by genre This system of S numbers quickly became the standard for identifying and cross referencing the music of Liszt both in academic circles and by general musicians In 2001 M ria Eckhardt and Rena Charnin Mueller introduced a new

system with LW numbers in The New Grove Dictionary though its complexities and omissions have limited its use The current Thematic Catalogue by Leslie Howard Minkyu Kim Aidan M dica and Michael Short is an attempt to preserve and amplify the work list in a comprehensive and comprehensible way retaining and extending the Searle enumeration The thematic catalogue organises all of Liszt s works including original compositions transcriptions alternative versions and missing or doubtful works It retains Searle numbers for continuity while expanding the list with newly discovered works to ensure a complete and coherent reference provides a connected view of multiple versions transcriptions and revisions with cross references ensuring no version is overlooked or misrepresented includes full thematic incipits for all works making identification of Liszt s pieces easier documents all known manuscripts first editions and revisions along with detailed references to Liszt s correspondence and significant scholarly articles offering essential historical context for research

Piano in Nineteenth-Century British Culture Susan Wollenberg, 2017-09-29 Since the publication of *The London Pianoforte School* ed Nicholas Temperley twenty years ago research has proliferated in the area of music for the piano during the late eighteenth and nineteenth centuries and into developments in the musical life of London for a time the centre of piano manufacturing publishing and performance But none has focused on the piano exclusively within Britain The eleven chapters in this volume explore major issues surrounding the instrument its performers and music within an expanded geographical context created by the spread of the instrument and the growth of concert touring Topics covered include the piano trade and how piano manufacturing affected a major provincial town the reception of Bach's *Well Tempered Clavier* and Clementi's *Gradus ad Parnassum* during the nineteenth century the shift from composer pianists to pianist interpreters in the first half of the century that triggered crucial changes in piano performance and concert structure the growth of musical life in the peripheries outside major musical centres the pianist as advocate for contemporary composers as well as for historical repertory the status of British pianists both in relation to foreigners on tour in Britain and as welcomed star performers in outposts of the Empire marketing forces that had an impact on piano sales concerts and piano careers leading virtuosos writers and critics the important role played by women pianists and the development of the recording industry bringing the volume into the early twentieth century

The Music Sound Nicolae Sfetcu, 2014-05-07 A guide for music compositions events forms genres groups history industry instruments language live music musicians songs musicology techniques terminology theory music video Music is a human activity which involves structured and audible sounds which is used for artistic or aesthetic entertainment or ceremonial purposes The traditional or classical European aspects of music often listed are those elements given primacy in European influenced classical music melody harmony rhythm tone color timbre and form A more comprehensive list is given by stating the aspects of sound pitch timbre loudness and duration Common terms used to discuss particular pieces include melody which is a succession of notes heard as some sort of unit chord which is a simultaneity of notes heard as some sort of unit chord progression which is a succession of chords simultaneity succession harmony which is the relationship between two or more pitches counterpoint which is the simultaneity and organization of different melodies and rhythm which is the organization of the durational aspects of music

Liszt Recomposed Nicolás Puyané, 2024 Explores Liszt's compositional processes and methods of revision as the product of the composer's interactions with a large variety of social cultural personal and political forces Franz Liszt 1811-86 is mostly known for his virtuosic piano works but his compositional achievements in the genre of song have so far been neglected Many of Liszt's *Lieder* exist in multiple versions sometimes radically altered and many with equal claims to authenticity This has sometimes been viewed as a barrier to performance and a hindrance to scholarly scrutiny Nicol's Puyan now redresses this imbalance and draws attention to this rich and varied corpus of works Liszt's songs contain a myriad of intertextual links not just with the songs of other composers but also with Liszt's own works in other genres and his own revisions By focusing on the multi version songs

the book uncovers how these intertextual relationships have evolved over time Introducing the concept of textual fluidity the book explores Liszt s compositional processes and methods of revision interpreting the work as being the product of the composer s interactions with a large variety of social cultural personal and political forces for instance the contemporaneous reception of Liszt s early Lieder or the change in Liszt s performing and compositional environments from his virtuoso to his Weimar years The book then offers close readings of selected songs including the Goethe and Schiller Lieder by applying the concept of textual fluidity Its findings will impact the way in which we see Urtext editions arguing instead for an online fluid text edition as an ideal resource with which to study Liszt s multi version compositions Dedicating Music, 1785-1850

Emily Green,2019 Why dedicate music What did dedications mean to their readers and writers especially after 1785 when more works were offered to fellow composers as well as to patrons Borrowing from book history and sociological theory Dedicating Music 1785 1850 is a large scale study of patterns of dedications Emily H Green argues that the kinds of offerings printed in the late eighteenth through mid nineteenth centuries reflect a changing financial and aesthetic landscape in which patronage was waning and independent artistry surging Dedications labeled written music as a gift while presenting composers with an opportunity for self promotion They also contributed to a new kind of branding of music by communicating composers friendships and artistic allegiances Dedicating Music considers dedications issued in print between 1785 and 1850 in sets of overlapping corpuses offerings to peers as in Mozart s string quartets dedicated to Haydn to patrons as in Ignaz Pleyel s string quartets for Count Erd dy to friends as in Ferdinand Ries s offerings for Beethoven and dedications issued by publishers as in Beethoven s song *In questa tomba oscura* included in publisher Tranquillo Mollo s collection offered to Prince Lobkowitz The result is a synchronic study that highlights the importance of printed packaging rather than notes on the page to the complex relationship between composers publishers and consumers of music EMILY H GREEN is Assistant Professor of Music at George Mason University The University of Rochester Press gratefully
