examining Jessica Hagedorn's *Dream Jungle* a novel inspired by the filming of *Apocalypse Now* she considers how the war's repercussions were felt in other countries in this case the Philippines Her investigation of Vietnamese American authors Lan Cao Andrew Lam and GB Tran adds a transnational dimension to the study SUSAN LYN EASTMAN teaches in the Department of English at the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga
