room design and arrangement with an emphasis on direct current supply alternative processes for the production of either chlorine or caustic without the other the production of hypochlorite industrial hygiene and speculations on future developments in technology There is an Appendix with selected physical property data The authors individually have extensive experience in chlor alkali technology but with diverse backgrounds and fields of specialization This allows them to achieve both the breadth and the depth which are offered here.
