

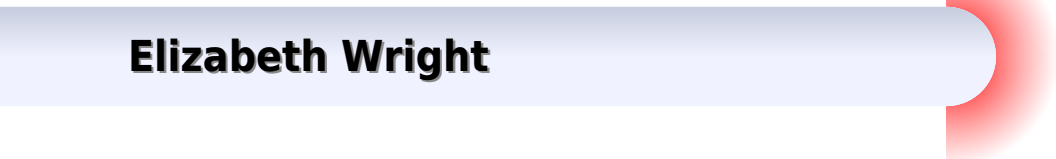

Literary Theory and Marxist Criticism Samiran Kumar Paul, 2020-11-28 The Communist Party's attitude toward art in this period was in general epiphenomenal of its economic policy A resolution of 1925 voiced the party's refusal to sanction anyone's literary faction This reflected the New Economic Policy NEP of a limited free market economy The period of the First Five Year Plan 1928-1932 saw a more or less voluntary return to a more committed artistic posture and during the second Five Year Plan 1932-1936 this commitment was crystallized in the formation of a Writers Union The first congress of this union in 1934 featuring speeches by Maxim Gorky and Bukharin officially adopted socialist realism as defined primarily by Andrei Zhdanov 1896-1948 Aptly dubbed by Terry Eagleton as Stalin's cultural thug it was Zhdanov whose proscriptive shadow thenceforward fell over Soviet cultural affairs Although Nikolai Bukharin's speech at the congress had attempted a synthesis of Formalist and sociological attitudes premised on his assertion that within the microcosm of the word is embedded the macrocosm of history Bukharin was eventually to fall from his position as the leading theoretician of the party his trial and execution stemming from his political and economic differences with Stalin were also symptomatic of the fact that Formalism soon became a sin once more Bukharin had called for socialist realism to portray not reality as it is but rather as it exists in socialist imagination

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
