Gless, 2008 In the aftermath of the Civil War legislators in the Nebraska Territory grappled with the responsibility of forming a state

government as well as with the larger issues of reconstructing the Union protecting civil rights and redefining federal state relations In the years that followed Nebraskans coped with regional and national economic collapses Nebraska women struggled for full recognition in the legal profession Meyer v Nebraska a case involving a teacher in a one room rural Nebraska schoolhouse changed the course of American constitutional doctrine and remains one of the cornerstones of civil liberties law And Roscoe Pound a boy from Lincoln went on to become one of the nation s great legal philosophers Nebraska holds a prominent position in the field of Native American legal history and the state s original inhabitants have been at the center of many significant developments in federal Indian policy Nebraska Indian legal history is replete with stories of failure and success heartache and triumph hardship and hope These stories are more than a mere record of the past of treaties broken or trials won they are reminders of the ongoing and sometimes tense relations among the many peoples and nations that make up the heartland Much of Nebraska law reflects mainstream American law yet Nebraskans also have been open to experiment and innovation The state revamped the legislative process by establishing the nation s only unicameral legislature and pioneered public employment collective bargaining and dispute resolution through its industrial relations commission and its relaxation of strict separation of powers These seemingly contradictory trends however are but differing expressions of a single underlying principle inscribed in the state s motto Equality Before the Law

Koistinen, 2004 Prolific munitions production keyed America s triumph in World War II but so did the complex economic controls needed to sustain that production Artillery tanks planes ships trucks and weaponry of every kind were constantly demanded by the military and readily supplied by American business While that relationship was remarkably successful in helping the U S win the war it also raised troubling issues about wartime economies that have never been fully resolved Paul Koistinen s fourth installment of a monumental five volume series on the political economy of American warfare focuses on the mobilization of national resources for a truly global war Koistinen comprehensively analyzes all relevant aspects of the World War II economy from 1940 through 1945 describing the nation s struggle to establish effective control over industrial supply and military demand and revealing the growing partnership

between the corporate community and the armed services Koistinen traces the evolution of federal agencies mobilizing for war including the National Defense Advisory Commission the Office of Production Management and the Supply Priorities and Allocation Board and then focuses on the work of the War Production Board from 1942 1945 As the war progressed the WPB and related agencies oversaw the military's supply and procurement systems stabilized the economy while financing the war closely monitored labor relations and controlled the shipping and rationing of fuel and food In chronicling American mobilization Koistinen reveals how representatives of industry and the armed services expanded upon their growing prewar ties to shape policies for harnessing the economy and how federal agencies were subsequently riven with dissension as New Deal reformers and anti New Deal corporate elements battled for control over mobilization itself As the armed services emerged as the principal customers of a command economy the military industrial nexus consolidated its power and ultimately succeeded in bending the reformers to its will The product of exhaustive archival research Arsenal of World War II shows that mobilization meant more than simply harnessing the economy for war it also involved struggles for power and position among a great many interest groups and ideologies Nearly two decades in the making it provides an ambitious and enormously insightful overview of the emergence of the military industrial economy one that still resonates today as America continues to wage wars around the globe

Louisiana during World War II Jerry Purvis Sanson,2020-04-01 While the impact of World War II on America and other countries has been exhaustively chronicled few historians have investigated the experiences of individual states during the tumultuous war years In his study of Louisiana s home front from 1939 to 1945 Jerry Purvis Sanson examines changes in politics education agriculture industry and society that forever altered the Pelican State The war era was a particularly important time in Louisiana s colorful political history The gubernatorial victories of prominent anti Huey Long candidates Sam Jones in 1940 and Jimmie Davis in 1944 reflected shifting sentiments toward politicians and heralded a changing of the guard in the statehouse This created a system of active dual faction politics that continued for the next decade The war also transformed the state s economy agricultural mechanization accelerated to compensate for labor shortages and industries increased production to meet military demands Louisiana s educational system modified its curriculum in response to the war providing technical training and sponsoring scrap metal collections and war stamp sales drives Sanson explores the war s effect on the everyday lives of Louisianians showing how their actions at home provided them with a sense of personal participation in the titanic effort against the Axis powers He also points out that while many found their lives limited by war two groups African Americans and women experienced increased opportunities as they moved from low paying jobs to more lucrative positions vacated by white males who had departed for the service Now condensed for easy and efficient access Sanson s historical account provides a wide ranging yet intimate look at how the war was brought home to the people of the Bayou State

Free Spaces Sara M. Evans,Harry C. Boyte,1992-04 What are the environments the public spaces in which ordinary people become participants in the complex ambiguous engaging conversation about democracy participators in governance rather than spectators or complainers victims or accomplices What are the roots not simply of movements against oppression but also of those democratic social movements which both enlarge the opportunities for participation and enhance people s ability to participate in the public world In *Free Spaces* Sara M Evans and Harry C Boyte argue for a new understanding of the foundations for democratic politics by analyzing the settings in which people learn to participate in democracy In their new Introduction the authors link the concept of free

spaces to recent theoretical discussions about community public life civil society and social movements *Smashing the Liquor Machine* Mark Lawrence Schrad, 2021 When most people think of the prohibition era they think of speakeasies gin runners and backwoods fundamentalists railing about the ills of strong drink In other words in the popular imagination it is a peculiarly American event Yet as Mark Lawrence Schrad shows in *Smashing the Liquor Machine* the conventional scholarship on prohibition is extremely misleading for a simple reason American prohibition was just one piece of a global wave of prohibition laws that occurred around the same time Schrad's counterintuitive global history of prohibition looks at the anti alcohol movement around the globe through the experiences of pro temperance leaders like Thomas Masaryk founder of Czechoslovakia Vladimir Lenin Leo Tolstoy and anti colonial activists in India Schrad argues that temperance wasn't American exceptionalism at all but rather one of the most broad based and successful transnational social movements of the modern era In fact Schrad offers a fundamental re appraisal of this colorful era to reveal that temperance forces frequently aligned with progressivism social justice liberal self determination democratic socialism labor rights women's rights and indigenous rights By placing the temperance movement in a deep global context he forces us to fundamentally rethink all that we think we know about the movement Rather than a motley collection of puritanical American evangelicals the global temperance movement advocated communal self protection against the corrupt and predatory liquor machine that had become exceedingly rich off the misery and addictions of the poor around the world from the slums of South Asia to central Europe to the Indian reservations of the American west Unlike many traditional dry histories *Smashing the Liquor Machine* gives voice to minority and subaltern figures who resisted the global liquor industry and further highlights that the impulses that led to the temperance movement were far more progressive and variegated than American readers have been led to believe

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
