Ranciere and Law Monica Lopez Lerma, Julen Etxabe, 2017-11-06 This book is the first to approach Jacques Ranci re s work from a legal perspective A former student of Louis Althusser Ranci re is one of the most important contemporary French philosophers of recent decades offering an original and path breaking way to think politics democracy and aesthetics Ranci re s work has received wide and increasing critical attention but no study exists so far that reflects on the wider implications of Ranci re for law and for socio legal studies Although Ranci re does not pay much specific attention to law and there is a strong temptation to identify law with what he terms the police order much of Ranci re s historical work highlights the creative potential of law and legal

language with important legal implications and ramifications So rather than excavate the Rancian corpus for isolated statements about the law this volume reverses such a method and asks what would a Rancian inspired legal theory look like Bringing together specialists and scholars in different areas of law critical theory and philosophy this rethinking of law and socio legal studies through Rancian provides an original and important engagement with a range of contemporary legal topics including constituent power and democracy legal subjectivity human rights practices of adjudication refugees the nomos of modernity and the sensory configurations of law It will then be of considerable interest to those working in these areas

Hughes, 2021-04-15 Shortlisted for the 2022 R Gapper book prize The formulation egalitarian strangeness is a direct borrowing from Courts voyages au pays du peuple Short Voyages to the Land of the People 1990 a collection of essays by the contemporary French thinker Jacques Rancian Perhaps best known for his theory of radical equality as set out in Le Maître ignorant The Ignorant Schoolmaster 1987 Rancian reflects on ways in which a hierarchical social order based on inequality can come to be unsettled In the democracy of literature for example he argues that words and sentences serve to capture any life and to make it available to any reader The present book explores embedded forms of social and cultural apportionment in a range of modern and contemporary French texts including prose fiction socially engaged commentary and autobiography while also identifying scenes of class disturbance and egalitarian encounter Part One considers the refrain of class audible in works by Claude Simon Charles Péguy Marie Ndiaye Thierry Beinstingel and Gabriel Guany and examines how these authors practices of language connect with that refrain In Part Two Hughes analyses forms of domination and dressage with reference to Simone Weil's mid 1930s factory journal Paul Nizan's novel of class alienation Antoine Bloy from the same decade and Pierre Michon's Vies minuscules Small Lives 1984 with its focus on obscure rural lives The reflection on how these narratives draw into contiguity antagonistic identities is extended in Part Three where individual chapters on Proust and the contemporary authors François Bon and Didier Eribon demonstrate ways in which enduring forms of cultural distribution are both consolidated and contested

Philosophy of Antifascism Devin Zane Shaw, 2020-06-11 On January 20th 2017 during an interview on the streets of Washington D C white nationalist Richard Spencer was punched by an anonymous antifascist The moment was caught on video and quickly went viral and soon punching Nazis was a topic of heated public debate How might this kind of militant action be conceived of or justified philosophically Can we find a deep commitment to antifascism in the history of philosophy Through the existentialism of Simone de Beauvoir with some reference to Fanon and Sartre this book identifies the philosophical reasons for the political action being enacted by contemporary antifascists In addition using the work of Jacques Rancian it argues that the alt right and the far right aren't a kind of politics at all but rather forms of parapolitical and paramilitary mobilization aimed at re-entrenching the power of the state and capital Devin Shaw argues that in order to resist fascist mobilization contemporary movements find a diversity of tactics more useful than principled nonviolence Antifascism must focus on the systemic causes

of the re emergence of fascism and thus must fight capital accumulation and the underlying white supremacism Providing new incisive interpretations of Beauvoir existentialism and Ranci re he makes the case for organizing a broader militant movement against fascism

Warhol's Working Class Anthony E. Grudin, 2017-10-20 This book explores Andy Warhol's creative engagement with social class During the 1960s as neoliberalism perpetuated the idea that fixed classes were a mirage and status an individual achievement Warhol's work appropriated images techniques and technologies that have long been described as generically American or middle class Drawing on archival and theoretical research into Warhol's contemporary cultural milieu Grudin demonstrates that these features of Warhol's work were in fact closely associated with the American working class The emergent technologies Warhol conspicuously employed to make his work home projectors tape recorders film and still cameras were advertised directly to the working class as new opportunities for cultural participation What's more some of Warhol's most iconic subjects Campbell's soup Brillo pads Coca Cola were similarly targeted since working class Americans under threat from a variety of directions were thought to desire the security and confidence offered by national brands Having propelled himself from an impoverished childhood in Pittsburgh to the heights of Madison Avenue Warhol knew both

sides of this equation the intense appeal that popular culture held for working class audiences and the ways in which the advertising industry hoped to harness this appeal in the face of growing middle class skepticism regarding manipulative marketing Warhol was fascinated by these promises of egalitarian individualism and mobility which could be profound and deceptive generative and paralyzing charged with strange forms of desire By tracing its intersections with various forms of popular culture including film music and television Grudin shows us how Warhol s work disseminated these promises while also providing a record of their intricate tensions and transformations

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
