support former slaves who escaped to Union lines struck a bargain they would fight for the Union only if they were granted their freedom Williams importantly demonstrates that freedom was not simply the absence of slavery but rather a dynamic process enacted by self emancipated African American refugees which compelled Lincoln to modify his war aims and place black freedom at the center of his wartime policies
