

Dialogic Teaching and Communicative approaches

The five principles for dialogic teaching (Alexander, 2006) which bring together the essential features of dialogic teaching in the classroom:

Collective: teachers and children address learning tasks together, whether as a group or as a class, rather than in isolation;

Reciprocal: teachers and children listen to each other, share idea and consider alternative viewpoints;

Supportive: children articulate their ideas freely, without fear of embarrassment over 'wrong' answers; and they help each other to reach common understandings; Cumulative: teachers and children build on their own and each others' ideas and chain them into coherent lines of thinking and enquiry;

Purposeful: teachers plan and facilitate dialogic teaching with particular educational goals in view.

Mortimer & Scott model of communicative approaches with four categories; interactive/authoritative, interactive/dialogic, non-interactive/dialogic, noninteractive/authoritative.
