- Results

- Due to poverty created by tenant farming and Colonial English policies, many Irish immigrated to America in search for a better life
 - Farmers became tenant farmers forced to rent land from English landlords. Many became migrant workers which meant spending months away from their families just to pay for the land and rent.

- Reasons

- The English see the rich lands of Ireland and covet them for raising their cattle. In their drive to become a major exporter of cattle they seize Irish lands and begin establishing cattle ranches while removing peasant farmers.
 - English view the Irish “savages” “outside of civilization” and “wild” thus feel the confiscation of their land is justified.
 - Most Irish were catholic which was not acceptable to the white Protestant English. Catholics weren't even allowed to vote during the 1700s.

- ENGLISH OPPRESSION

- The Irish were treated as second-class Citizens in their own country

- The English took over the lands of Ireland and reduced the citizens to their state of poverty. Claims that the Irish were “wild” and “outside of civilization” Help them justify the land confiscation and abuses of its native citizens.
 - When in reality after a trip to Ireland Ben Franklin describes British colonies them as having, “reduced the Irish people to extremely poor tenants, living in the most sordid wretchedness, in dirty hovels of mud and straw, clothed only in rags.”

- Living under English Oppression

- THE POTATO FAMINE

- Unknown fungus that infects potato crops of Ireland resulting in even more desperate times for tenant farmers. Over the next 10 years over 1 million Irish people die of sickness and starvation.
 - Cattle exports would have more than fed the starving Irish population. However English landlords chose not to help them and continue charging their high rent for farmlands.

Massacring Indians Roger L. Nichols, 2021-03-04 During the nineteenth century the U S military fought numerous battles against American Indians These so called Indian wars devastated indigenous populations and some of the conflicts stand out

today as massacres as they involved violent attacks on often defenseless Native communities including women and children Although historians have written full length studies about each of these episodes *Massacring Indians* is the first to present them as part of a larger pattern of aggression perpetuated by heartless or inept military commanders In clear and accessible prose veteran historian Roger L Nichols examines ten significant massacres committed by U S Army units against American Indians The battles range geographically from Alabama to Montana and include such well known atrocities as Sand Creek Washita and Wounded Knee Nichols explores the unique circumstances of each event including its local context At the same time looking beyond the confusion and bloodshed of warfare he identifies elements common to all the massacres Unforgettable details emerge in the course of his account inadequate training of U S soldiers overeagerness to punish Indians an inflated desire for glory among individual officers and even careless mistakes resulting in attacks on the wrong village or band As the author chronicles the collective tragedy of the massacres he highlights the roles of well known frontier commanders ranging from Andrew Jackson to John Chivington and George Armstrong Custer In many cases Nichols explains it was lower ranking officers who bore the responsibility and blame for the massacres even though orders came from the higher ups During the nineteenth century and for years thereafter white settlers repeatedly used the term massacre to describe Indian raids rather than the reverse They lacked the understanding to differentiate such raids Indians defending their homeland against invasion from the aggressive decimation of peaceful Indian villages by U S troops Even today it may be tempting for some to view the massacres as exceptions to the norm By offering a broader synthesis of the attacks *Massacring Indians* uncovers a more disturbing truth that slaughtering innocent people was routine practice for U S troops and their leaders

The Store in the Hood Steven J.
