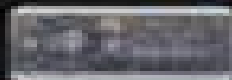


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Naive Lie Theory John Stillwell, 2008-12-15 In this new textbook acclaimed author John Stillwell presents a lucid introduction to Lie theory suitable for junior and senior level undergraduates In order to achieve this he focuses on the so called classical groups that capture the symmetries of real complex and quaternion spaces These symmetry groups may be represented by matrices which allows them to be studied by elementary methods from calculus and linear algebra This naive approach to Lie theory is originally due to von Neumann and it is now possible to streamline it by using standard results of undergraduate mathematics To compensate for the limitations of the naive approach end of chapter discussions introduce important results beyond those proved in the book as part of an informal sketch of Lie theory and its history John Stillwell is Professor of Mathematics at the University of San Francisco He is the author of several highly regarded books published by Springer including *The Four Pillars of Geometry* 2005 *Elements of Number Theory* 2003 *Mathematics and Its History* Second Edition 2002 *Numbers and Geometry* 1998 and *Elements of Algebra* 1994 Access Control, Security, and Trust Shiu-Kai

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messages and elliptic curves that you can read cover to cover It grew out of undergraduate courses that the author taught at Harvard UC San Diego and the University of Washington The systematic study of number theory was initiated around 300 B C when Euclid proved that there are infinitely many prime numbers and also cleverly deduced the fundamental theorem of arithmetic which asserts that every positive integer factors uniquely as a product of primes Over a thousand years later around 972 A D Arab mathematicians formulated the congruent number problem that asks for a way to decide whether or not a given positive integer n is the area of a right triangle all three of whose sides are rational numbers Then another thousand years later in 1976 Diffie and Hellman introduced the first ever public key cryptosystem which enabled two people to communicate secretly over a public communications channel with no predetermined secret this invention and the ones that followed it revolutionized the world of digital communication In the 1980s and 1990s elliptic curves revolutionized number theory providing striking new insights into the congruent number problem primality testing public key cryptography attacks on public key systems and playing a central role in Andrew Wiles resolution of Fermat's Last Theorem

Silverman, 2008-12-15 The creation of public key cryptography by Diffie and Hellman in 1976 and the subsequent invention of the RSA public key cryptosystem by Rivest Shamir and Adleman in 1978 are watershed events in the long history of secret communications It is hard to overestimate the importance of public key cryptosystems and their associated digital signature schemes in the modern world of computers and the Internet This book provides an introduction to the theory of public key cryptography and to the mathematical ideas underlying that theory Public key cryptography draws on many areas of mathematics including number theory abstract algebra probability and information theory Each of these topics is introduced and developed in sufficient detail so that this book provides a self-contained course for the beginning student The only prerequisite is a first course in linear algebra On the other hand students with stronger mathematical backgrounds can move directly to cryptographic applications and still have time for advanced topics such as elliptic curve pairings and lattice reduction algorithms Among the many facets of modern cryptography this book chooses to concentrate primarily on public key cryptosystems and digital signature schemes This allows for an in depth development of the necessary mathematics required for both the construction of these schemes and an analysis of their security The reader who masters the material in this book will not only be well prepared for further study in cryptography but will have acquired a real understanding of the underlying mathematical principles on which modern cryptography is based
