

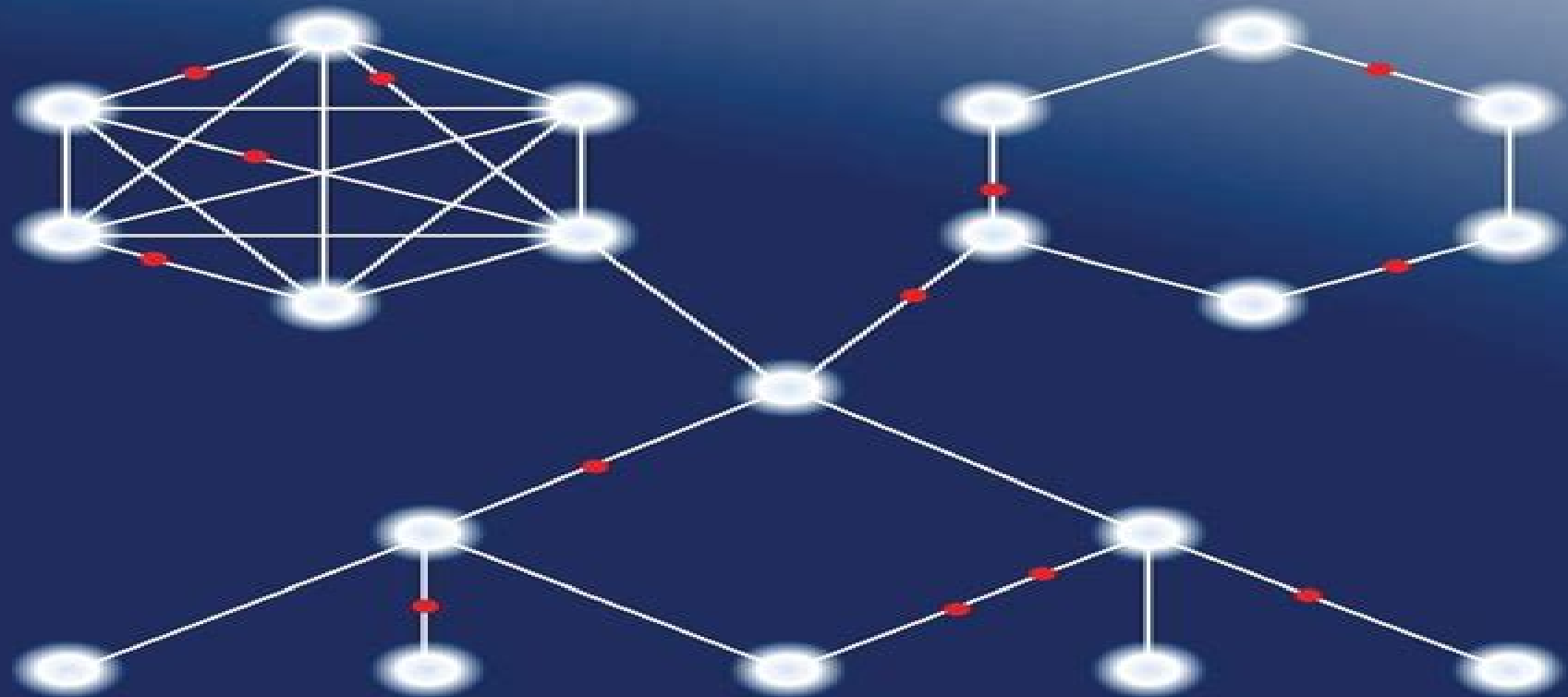

Edsger Wybe Dijkstra Krzysztof R. Apt, Tony Hoare, 2022-07-14 Edsger Wybe Dijkstra 1930 2002 was one of the most influential researchers in the history of computer science making fundamental contributions to both the theory and practice of computing Early in his career he proposed the single source shortest path algorithm now commonly referred to as Dijkstra's algorithm He wrote with Jaap Zonneveld the first ALGOL 60 compiler and designed and implemented with his colleagues the influential THE operating system Dijkstra invented the field of concurrent algorithms with concepts such as mutual exclusion deadlock detection and synchronization A prolific writer and forceful proponent of the concept of structured programming he convincingly argued against the use of the Go To statement In 1972 he was awarded the ACM Turing Award for fundamental contributions to programming as a high intellectual challenge for eloquent insistence and practical demonstration that programs should be composed correctly not just debugged into correctness for illuminating perception of problems at the foundations of program design Subsequently he invented the concept of self stabilization relevant to fault tolerant computing He also devised an elegant language for nondeterministic programming and its weakest precondition semantics featured in his influential 1976 book A Discipline of Programming in which he advocated the development of programs in concert with their correctness proofs In the later stages of his life he devoted much attention to the development and presentation of mathematical proofs providing further support to his long held view that the programming process should be viewed as a mathematical activity In this

unique new book 31 computer scientists including five recipients of the Turing Award present and discuss Dijkstra's numerous contributions to computing science and assess their impact Several authors knew Dijkstra as a friend teacher lecturer or colleague Their biographical essays and tributes provide a fascinating multi author picture of Dijkstra from the early days of his career up to the end of his life

Introduction to Distributed Self-Stabilizing

Algorithms Karine Altisen, Stéphane Devismes, Swan Dubois, Franck Petit, 2022-05-31 This book aims at being a comprehensive and pedagogical introduction to the concept of self stabilization introduced by Edsger Wybe Dijkstra in 1973 Self stabilization characterizes the ability of a distributed algorithm to converge within finite time to a configuration from which its behavior is correct i.e. satisfies a given specification regardless the arbitrary initial configuration of the system This arbitrary initial configuration may be the result of the occurrence of a finite number of transient faults Hence self stabilization is actually considered as a versatile non masking fault tolerance approach since it recovers from the effect of any finite number of such faults in a unified manner Another major interest of such an automatic recovery method comes from the difficulty of resetting malfunctioning devices in a large scale and so geographically spread distributed system the Internet Pair to Pair networks and Delay Tolerant Networks are examples of such distributed systems Furthermore self

stabilization is usually recognized as a lightweight property to achieve fault tolerance as compared to other classical fault tolerance approaches. Indeed, the overhead both in terms of time and space of state of the art self stabilizing algorithms is commonly small. This makes self stabilization very attractive for distributed systems equipped of processes with low computational and memory capabilities such as wireless sensor networks. After more than 40 years of existence, self stabilization is now sufficiently established as an important field of research in theoretical distributed computing to justify its teaching in advanced research oriented graduate courses. This book is an initiation course which consists of the formal definition of self stabilization and its related concepts followed by a deep review and study of classical simple algorithms commonly used proof schemes and design patterns as well as premium results issued from the self stabilizing community. As often happens in the self stabilizing area, in this book we focus on the proof of correctness and the analytical complexity of the studied distributed self stabilizing algorithms. Finally, we underline that most of the algorithms studied in this book are actually dedicated to the high level atomic state model which is the most commonly used computational model in the self stabilizing area. However, in the last chapter, we present general techniques to achieve self stabilization in the low level message passing model as well as example algorithms.

Fault-Tolerant Message-Passing Distributed Systems Michel Raynal, 2018-09-08. This book presents the most important fault tolerant distributed programming abstractions and their associated distributed algorithms in particular in terms of reliable communication and agreement which lie at the heart of nearly all distributed applications. These programming abstractions, distributed objects or services, allow software designers and programmers to cope with asynchrony and the most important types of failures such as process crashes, message losses, and malicious behaviors of computing entities, widely known under the term Byzantine fault tolerance. The author introduces these notions in an incremental manner, starting from a clear specification followed by algorithms which are first described intuitively and then proved correct. The book also presents impossibility results in classic distributed computing models along with strategies, mainly failure detectors and randomization, that allow us to enrich these models. In this sense, the book constitutes an introduction to the science of distributed computing with applications in all domains of distributed systems such as cloud computing and blockchains. Each chapter comes with exercises and bibliographic notes to help the reader approach, understand, and master the fascinating field of fault tolerant distributed computing.
